BRAKING



BEDDING NEW PADS AND ROTORS



CAUTION:

Proceed with caution. Do not use brake system heavily until the following procedure has been completed. It is very important to follow proper brake bedding procedure following installation. This is necessary for optimal performance of the system.



NOTE:

These **directions** must be completed before driving the vehicle as normal.

While vehicle is stationary, pump brakes to ensure a firm pedal.

Drive vehicle slowly & cautiously at first to test fit and function of replacement brake pads and rotors.

Brakes should be smooth, with no vibrations, judder, etc.

Drive the vehicle to a remote area and perform 20-30 brake applications of 3 second duration while not coming to a complete stop. Use light/medium deceleration with varying starting speeds. Leave at least ½ mile between each brake application.

The purpose of this procedure is to gradually increase the temperature in the components without thermal shock, and to mate the brake pad and disc friction surfaces.

After the repeated stops, drive the vehicle for several miles with little or no braking in order to adequately cool the components.

For the next 320 Kilometers please allow for short and smooth braking to allow for correct alignment between pads and disc surface. During this time there should be no vibrations or noises.

The system is now ready for normal use.

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
