

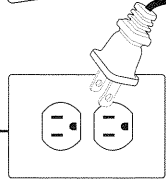

GETTING STARTED

Plug the power cord into a standard outlet; the digital display will flash.



ADJUSTING DISPLAY BRIGHTNESS

Slide the switch left (HI) for a brighter display.

Slide the switch right (LO) for a normal display brightness.

TIME SET

While pressing and holding the TIME SET button, the HOUR & MINUTE buttons are needed to change the time.

Note: When setting the time, make sure you are in the correct AM or PM period as indicated by PM indicator on the display.

ALARM SET

While pressing and holding the ALARM set button, press the HOUR & MINUTES button as needed to change the Alarm time.

Note: When setting the alarm, make sure you are in the correct AM or PM period as indicated by PM indicator on the display.

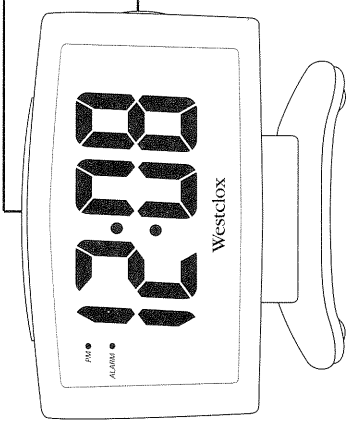
ALARM ON / OFF (ALARM VOLUME CONTROL)

To turn the alarm on, slide the alarm switch to either the HI or LO position as indicated above the switch. On the front of the clock, the **ALARM ON** indicator dot will be lit.

Note: When turning alarm on, choose between HI and LO for volume.

SNOOZE

Press down on the SNOOZE bar when the alarm is sounding. The alarm will be silenced temporarily, but will resume sounding after 9 minutes.

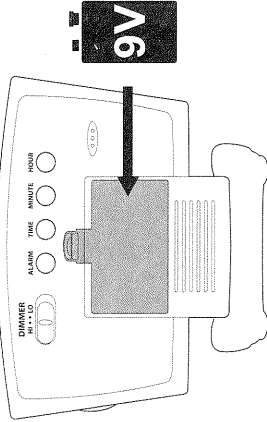


OPTIONAL: INSTALLING or REPLACING THE BACKUP BATTERIES

#1 Remove battery cover, located on the back of the clock.

#2 Insert 1 fresh alkaline "9 Volt" battery. Make sure the battery snaps in firmly.

#3 Replace battery cover.



NOTE: The battery backup feature is not necessary to operate your digital alarm clock. It is optional to have the battery backup in case of a power outage.

IMPORTANT: Extended storage can cause batteries to leak and damage the unit. Leaky batteries should be discarded immediately. Skin burns or other personal injury can result. Always dispose of batteries according to federal, state and local regulations.

IMPORTANT:
- Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
- Remove battery from equipment which is not to be used for an extended period of time.
- Remove used battery promptly.
