


5 GENERAL OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds to turn the camera on.

Functions during image transmission

Line up the camera head on the flexible cable and move it to the required position.

If lighting conditions are poor, switch on the LED lighting by pressing button.


Zoom in on distant or small objects by pressing button.

The manual flip function enables the image to be flipped horizontally and vertically by pressing .

Live Viewing

View on Display Screen or use RCA cable to view on external monitor.

1. Press and hold the Power button to turn camera on.
2. LED lighting: Press button to dim and turn off light.
3. Flip image: Press the button to flip image horizontally and vertically.
4. Enlarge image: Press the button to enlarge the image.



This inspection camera features a micro-camera which sends colour video images to the LCD so that areas which are difficult to access (cavities, shafts, masonry or inside cars, for example) can be checked.



NOTE:

The camera focus is set to 3 cm - 7 cm. Objects outside this range may appear blurred.



1. Attaching Accessories:

- Carefully slide the accessory onto the camera head.
- To remove accessory, carefully slide the accessory off the camera head.



2. Connecting to External Monitor with RCA Cable:

Plug one end into the RCA video out port on camera, then plug other end into RCA video in port on monitor.

When finished, press and hold the Power button to turn the Camera off, then clean and store according to "Inspection and Maintenance."
