SAFETY

To reduce the risk of serious injury, read the following safety instructions before assembling and using the workbench.

- This product is intended for domestic indoor use only. Do not use it as scaffold. Do not stand on it as this could result in personal injury or product damage.
- This product should be positioned on a level, stable surface only. Failure to do so can result in unit failure, poor product performance or a possible safety hazard.
- Any assembly or maintenance of the product must be carried out by adults only. It is recommended to have at least 2 people lift this box and assemble the product.
- Always wear gloves when assembling this product to prevent cuts or abrasions.
- Never use replacement parts which are not recommended by the manufacturer. They could pose a safety risk to the user and might cause damage to the product.
- Do not exceed the following weight limits for this workbench:
 - Maximum load for whole workbench: 600 lb (272.2 kg)
 - Maximum load for the drawer: 100 lb (45.4 kg)
 - Maximum load for the bench top is 350 lb (158.8 kg)

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

To begin the assembly of this workbench, place all parts from the packaging box and arrange them on a clear, level surface. Ensure that all parts listed are present.

Remove all packaging materials and place them back in the box. Do not dispose of the packaging materials until assembly is complete.

ASSEMBLY CAUTION

Ensure that the plug is inserted into the bottom of the keyhole while assembling.

TOOLS REQUIRED (NOT INCLUDED)

Rubber mallet	
Cross-head screwdriver	

WARNING!

- Be careful while handling metal edges.
- Work gloves are recommended for assembling this unit.
- Never exceed recommended maximum load capacity.

NOTE!

- Easy assembly process, no hardware is required. Use a rubber mallet to tap the pins into place.

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Attach four rubber feet (1) to two front posts (2LF and 2RF) and two rear posts (3LR and 3RR).

STEP 2

Attach two short bottom beams (5) to the right and left. Attach the front lowercase long bottom beam (6F) to (2LF and 2RF). Gently tap with rubber mallet to secure into place.

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 3

Attach drawer slide panel (4L and 4R) to both sides. Insert the left drawer slide panel (4L) into the second hole of (2LF). DO NOT insert it into the third hole of 3LR (refer to STEP 10). Insert the right drawer slide panel (4R) into the second hole of (2RF). DO NOT insert it into the third hole of (3RR) (refer to the STEP10). Ensure the two drawer slide panels will open outwards in the same direction. Gently tap with rubber mallet to secure into place.

STEP 4

Attach the bench top (7) onto posts. Two persons are required for this step. One of them holds the opposite side while the other person inserts the bench top onto the two front posts (2LF and 2RF). Next, insert bench top (7) onto two rear posts (3LR and 3RR) by bending outwards a little. Gently tap with rubber mallet to secure into place.

CAUTION!

Pay attention not to jam your hands during bench top assembly. Be careful!

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 5

Connect the upper left post (9L) to the left rear post (3LR), and attach the upper right post (9R) to the right rear post (3RR). Make sure the keyhole slot is facing down. Carefully tap the posts into place with rubber mallet.

STEP 6

Attach the pegboard (10) to the two upper posts (9L and 9R). Make sure the keyhole slot is facing down. Carefully tap the pegboard into place with rubber mallet.

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 7

Connect the back shelf beam (12) to the upper left post (9L) and upper right post (9R). Make sure the keyhole slot is facing down. Carefully tap the beam into place with rubber mallet.

STEP 8

Attach the top shelf (13) to the left side shelf beam (11L) and right side shelf beam (11R). Then, attach (11L and 11R) to (9L and 9R). Gently tap with rubber mallet to secure into place.

STEP 9

Attach the rear lowercase long bottom beam (6R) to (3LR and 3RR). Gently tap with rubber mallet to secure into place.

STEP 10

Insert the left drawer slide panel (4L) to the third hole of (3LR). Insert the right drawer slide panel (4R) to the third hole of (3RR). Then fasten the screws by using a cross-head screwdriver. Make sure the screws are fastened tightly.

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MAINTENANCE

STEP 11

Insert the drawer (8) into place. Extend drawer slides from the drawer slide panels (4L and 4R). Carefully align the brackets of each side of the drawer (8) with the slides from the drawer slide panels (4L and 4R). Insert the brackets into the drawer slides as shown below. Once the drawer brackets are properly inserted into the drawer slides, push the drawer all the way in and pull out to make sure the slides are locked together. Now the workbench assembly is completed.

MAINTENANCE

- Clean the product with a clean cloth to remove any manufacturing residues before first use. A damp cloth can be used for cleaning on a regular basis.
- Grease and oil can be removed with most standard cleaning fluids. For safety, use a non-flammable cleaning fluid. Do not use abrasive materials, cleansers, chemicals, bleach, or solvents.
- Lubricate the gliding slides with grease or equivalent (at least twice a year).
- To maintain the best appearance of your product, apply some quality car wax after cleaning. Apply the wax as you would to a car. The wax will also help protect the product against scratches.

CAUTION!

- Complete the workbench assembly in the place where it will be used. Do not disassemble or assemble often as it may lead to looseness in the connections.
- When moving this workbench, ensure the four posts are held by hand.

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WARRANTY

This Mastercraft product is guaranteed for a period of one (1) year from the date of original retail purchase, against defects in materials and workmanship.

Subject to the conditions and limitations described below, this product, if returned to us with proof of purchase within the stated warranty period and if covered under this warranty, will be repaired or replaced with the same model, or one of equal value or specification, at our option. We will bear the cost of any repair or replacement and any costs of labour relating thereto.

THIS WARRANTY IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS:

- A bill of sale verifying the purchase and purchase date must be provided.
- This warranty will not apply to any product or part thereof which is worn or broken or which has become inoperative due to abuse, misuse, accidental damage, neglect or lack of proper installation, operation or maintenance (as outlined in the applicable owner's manual or operating instructions) or which is being used for industrial, professional, commercial or rental purposes.
- This warranty will not apply to normal wear and tear or to expendable parts or accessories that may be supplied with the product which are expected to become inoperative or unusable after a reasonable period of use.
- This warranty will not apply to routine maintenance and consumable items such as, but not limited to, fuel, lubricants, vacuum bags, blades, belts, sandpaper, bits, fluids, tune-ups or adjustments.
- This warranty will not apply where damage is caused by repairs made or attempted by others (i.e., persons not authorized by the manufacturer).
- This warranty will not apply to any product that was sold to the original purchaser as a reconditioned or refurbished product (unless otherwise specified in writing).
- This warranty will not apply to any product or part thereof if any part from another manufacturer is installed therein or any repairs or alterations have been made or attempted by unauthorized persons.
- This warranty will not apply to normal deterioration of the exterior finish, such as, but not limited to, scratches, dents, paint chips, or to any corrosion or discolouring by heat, abrasive and chemical cleaners.
- This warranty will not apply to component parts sold by and identified as the product of another company, which shall be covered under the product manufacturer's warranty, if any.

This warranty applies only to the original purchaser and may not be transferred.
