- CLOSE AND LOCK DRAWERS BEFORE MOVING THIS PRODUCT. They could come open and make the product unstable, which may cause personal injury or product damage.
- DO NOT let children near the tool chest combo.
- DO NOT open more than one drawer at a time.
- Fill from the bottom drawer up. If the tool chest combo is filled from the top drawer down, it will be top-heavy and may fall over.
- DO NOT attempt to lift the unit by the side handle using chains, ropes or other lifting devices. The side handle could fail, which may cause personal injury or damage to the product.
- DO NOT step or climb on this product or on the drawers.






• 10 mm wrench for M6 hex bolts

HANDLE INSTALLATION

NOTE:

Holes in the cabinet are tapped requiring no nuts for installation. Side handle should be mounted on the same side of the cabinet as the swivel castors.

Position the side handle (19) over the holes and attach with four M6x12 hex bolts (5) provided. Tighten securely.




CASTOR INSTALLATION

NOTE:

You may require the assistance of another person to complete this step.

NOTE:

For easy movement, the swivel castors are suggested to be installed on the side of the side handle.




Carefully lay the cabinet on its back with a soft mat underneath for protection. Position the two rigid castors (14) on one side of the bottom of the cabinet. Insert the M8 \times 20 hex bolts (16) through washers (17), then through the castors and into the bottom of the cabinet. Tighten securely.

Repeat for the two swivel castors (18) on the other side of the cabinet. Return the cabinet to the upright position.


DRAWER REMOVAL

Empty the drawer. Pull the drawer out until almost fully extended. There are two black release levers, one on each side of the drawer. Pull up the black release lever on one side, while pushing down the black release lever on the other side. While holding the levers in the positions as instructed above, pull the drawer outward until it is released from the drawer slide.



DRAWER REPLACEMENT

Extend the drawer slides from the tool chest or cabinet. Insert the brackets on each side of the drawer into the slots in the slides, being careful that they are properly positioned. Once properly inserted, completely close the drawer to set the slides in their proper positions.




CHESTS AND CABINET CONNECTION



The connector works well for both of the cabinets with or without wood top.


To work with the wood top:


 Just simply place the chest on top. Attach the two connectors (6) to the combo and fasten each with three M6 x 12 hex bolts (5).



To work without the wood top:

- Follow the instructions above to remove at least five drawers until you can loosen the eight screws from the wood top.
- Remove the eight screws first and remove the wood top.
- Install the drawers back. At this time, you can place the chest on the cabinet.
- Attach the two connectors (6) to the combo and fasten each with three M6 x 12 hex bolts (5).





RAISE-AND-RELEASE DRAWER FRONTS

These units are equipped with raise-and-release drawer fronts. To open, lift up on the drawer front while pulling towards you. To close, shut the drawer firmly until the latch engages.





GENERAL MAINTENANCE

- For castors, use high-quality bearing grease once a year.
- Lubricate the slides twice a year with a spray lubricant or light-duty oil.
- Periodically clean the drawer fronts, drawer trim and other surfaces with mild detergent and water.
- Grease and oil can be removed with most standard cleaning fluids.

LIMITED WARRANTY
