

# **INTENDED USE**


This tool chest was designed to hold tools, hardware and other items. This storage system is set on casters. The toolbox can be used as a portable work station to organize contents.

# PREPARATION BEFORE ASSEMBLY

- 1. Verify that the product and application are compatible. If in doubt call Customer Service.
- 2. Before use, read the operator's manual completely and familiarize yourself thoroughly with the product and all components, and recognize the potential hazards associated with its use.
- 3. When unpacking, make sure that the item is intact and undamaged. If any parts are missing or broken, please contact Customer Service.
- 4. Assemble only according to these instructions. Improper assembly can create hazards.
- 5. Wear ANSI-approved safety goggles and heavy-duty work gloves during assembly.
- 6. Keep assembly area clean and well lit.
- 7. Stay alert. Use caution and common sense when operating. Do not assemble or operate when tired, incoherent, dizzy, or under the use of drugs or alcohol.

# **ASSEMBLY PARTS INCLUDED**

Carefully unpack and spread out all the parts in a large area. Familiarize yourself with all the parts and compare them with the drawings below. Verify that parts are included in packaging. Read all assembly instructions before beginning.




# **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

# HANDLE ASSEMBLY

For the handle assembly you will need parts 1 and 2 as shown in the assembly diagram.

- 1. Align the handle with the side panel of bottom tool box (#1).
- 2. Insert M6x12 mm bolts provided and tighten with a 10 mm wrench.
- 3. Once handle is attached verify that fasteners are tight.


# CASTER KIT ASSEMBLY

For the caster kit assembly you will need parts 4, 5, 6 and 7 as shown in the assembly diagram.

- 1. Lock empty drawers of the tool box.
- 2. Lay the tool box on its back onto the flattened shipping carton to prevent paint scratches.

Note: Mount both locking casters on the same side as the handle.


- 3. Align the caster mounting bracket with the holes on the bottom of the tool box. Hold in place until steps 3, 5, 6, and 4, (7) are complete.
- 4. Attach the mounting plate with bolt and 10 mm washer provided (#5 and #6). Tighten with a 17 mm wrench.
- 5. Repeat this for the other three mounting bolts.
- 6. Repeat steps 1, 2 and 3.
- 7. Once all four caster wheels are attached, with help carefully raise the bottom tool box back into the upright position.
- 8. Test to verify casters and caster wheel locks are operating properly.



#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

#### FINAL ASSEMBLY

- Assemble on a at, level, hard and smooth surface capable of safely supporting a fully loaded Top Chest and Cabinet.
- 2. Locate the Keys, label them, then put them in a safe place.
- Note: The Bottom Cabinet and Top Chest have di erent sets of keys.
- 3. Using an assistant, place EMPTY Top Chest on top of Bottom Cabinet.
- 4. WARNING! Make sure the Top Chest is seated inside the Bottom Cabinet's edges.



#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### TOP CHEST

- 1. To LOCK chest, close all drawers first, close lid then turn key to the left.
- 2. To UN-LOCK chest, turn key to the right, open lid and slide drawer out.
- To OPEN DRAWERS, turn key to the right and pull up on drawer handle, then slide drawer out.
- 4. To CLOSE DRAWERS, gently close drawer. Verify drawer has latched closed.

#### MIDDLE CHEST AND BOTTOM TOOL CABINET

- 1. Close all drawers first then turn key to the left.
- 2. Turn key to the right and slide drawer out.
- 3. To OPEN DRAWERS, turn key to the right and pull up on drawer handle, then slide drawer out.
- 4. To CLOSE DRAWERS, gently close drawer. Verify drawer has latched closed.



DO NOT slam the drawers as they will not lock'and damage I nay occur to lock bar tabs or lock pockets.

# **CARE AND MAINTENANCE**


- Dust may be removed with a damp cloth.
- Lubricate the slides with grease or equivelant (twice yearly).
- For casters, use high quality bearing grease (yearly).
- Periodically the drawer fronts, drawer trim, and other surfaces should be cleaned with water.
- Grease and oil can be removed with most standard cleaning uids. For safety, use a non- ammable cleaning uid.
- If drawer liners are supplied, it is recommended they are used to protect the nish inside the drawers and to make the drawer easier to clean. The drawer liners may be cleaned with soap and water.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

- DO NOT slam the drawers as they will not lock, and damage may occur to lock bar tabs or lock pockets.
- Should damage occur, remove the drawers following the drawer removal instructions below.
- With a screwdriver or pliers straighten out the Lock Bar Tab and the Lock Pocket.

If it becomes necessary to remove drawers, follow these drawer removal instructions:

- To REMOVE drawers:
   Simultaneously press the plastic lock spring up or down on the ball bearing sliders and pull the inner drawer slide out.
- To REASSEMBLE drawers: Insert the end of the inner drawer slide into the middle drawer, then carefully slide into place. If inserted correctly a clicking sound will be




heard when drawer is in place. Verify slide is attached after reassembling.


