

SAFETY GUIDELINES

This manual contains information that relates to PROTECTING PERSONAL SAFETY and PREVENTING EQUIPMENT PROBLEMS. It is very important to read this manual carefully and understand it thoroughly before using the product. The symbols listed below are used to indicate this information.



CAUTION!

Potential hazard that may result in moderate injury or damage to equipment.

- The storage cabinet should be positioned on a level surface.
- This storage cabinet is intended for indoor use only.
- Check all nuts and bolts periodically and tighten them, if required.
- Use a slightly damp, soft cloth to clean the storage cabinet.
- Do not stand on storage cabinet and do not use it as a scaffold.
- Do not exceed the maximum load of 1000 lb (450 kg).
- Any assembly or maintenance of the storage cabinet must be carried out by adults only.
- Do not assemble or move the storage cabinet without necessary manpower.
- Do not exceed the following weight limits for this product.

Each shelf: 200 lb (91 kg)

Bottom panel: 400 lb (182 kg)


































Assembly Preparation

- Assemble the storage cabinet on a clean, level surface.
- Remove all items from the packaging box and ensure that all parts listed on page 4 are included.
- When installing parts that have more than one screw, tighten all screws by hand before tightening them with the screwdriver.


Assembly Instructions




1. Attach the left panel (Part 1) and right panel (Part 2) to the top panel (Part 3). Insert three M4 X 8 screws (Part 19) into each side of the panels and tighten them using the screwdriver (Part 21) (*fig A*).

NOTE: Make sure the front of the cabinet frame is facing down. Once the cabinet frame is assembled, turn the cabinet frame to the upright position to attach the back panels.

NOTE: As the cabinet frame is assembled upside down, use carpet or blanket while assembling the cabinet so that cabinet front does not get scratched.




2. Attach the left panel (Part 1) and right panel (Part 2) to the bottom panel (Part 4). Insert three M4 X 30 screws (Part 20) into each side of the panels and tighten them using the screwdriver (*fig B*).




 Attach the bottom back panel (Part 10), middle back panels (Part 9) and upper back panel (Part 8) to the assembled cabinet frame. Starting from the bottom back panel, insert the M4 X 8 screws (Part 19) into the screw holes of all the back panels and tighten them using the screwdriver (fig C).


NOTE: Two screw holes for corner protectors are reserved across the top panel and the bottom panel.



- 4. Install the levelling feet (Part 24) on the bottom panel (Part 4) using the wrench (Part 25) (*fig D*).
- 5. Turn the cabinet frame to the upright position.



6. Choose the desired height for placing each middle shelf (Part 5) inside the cabinet. Then pull down the hooks (Part 13) into the hook slots provided, making sure the four hooks are placed at the same height. Place the shelves into the cabinet frame and press them down onto the hooks (fig E).




7. Attach one of two magnets (Part 23) to the top panel (Part 3) and another magnet to the bottom panel (Part 4). Insert two M4 X 8 screws (Part 19) into each magnet and tighten them using the screwdriver (*fig F*).


NOTE: The black plate of the magnet should be facing the front.



8. Attach the left door (Part 6) and right door (Part 7) on corresponding sides of the cabinet frame. Insert 10 M4 X 8 screws (Part 19) into the doors and tighten them using the screwdriver (*fig G*).




9. Place the bumpers (Part 14) on the bottom panel. Insert four M4 X 18 screws (Part 18) into the bumpers and tighten them using the screwdriver. Then place the corner protector A (Part 16) and corner protector B (Part 15) on the top panel (Part 3). Insert five M4 X 8 screws (Part 19) into each corner protector and tighten them using the screwdriver (*fig H*).



- 10. Install Mounting Strap (Part 60) (fig I).
 - A. Remove M4 X 8 screw (Part 19) from the back corner protection.
 - B. Attach the mounting strap (Part 60) to the back corner protection brackets as Fig. I shows using M4 X 12 screw (Part 61) and M4 washer (Part 27).
 - C. Drill a hole in the wall with a 5/16" drill bill and insert the wall anchor (Part 55-A) into the hole.
 - D. Attach the other end of the mounting strap (Part 60) to the wall using M6 X 50 screw (Part 55) and M8 washer (Part 27-B).

Repeat steps A through D to install the other mounting strap.



11. The storage cabinet is ready to be used. Use the keys (Part 22) to lock the left door (Part 6) and right door (Part 7), if desired (*fig J*).

 applicable owner's manual or operating instructions) or which is being used for industrial, professional, commercial or rental
 purposes;
- c. this warranty will not apply to normal wear and tear or to expendable parts or accessories that may be supplied with the product which are expected to become inoperative or unusable after a reasonable period of use;
- d. this warranty will not apply to routine maintenance and consumable items such as, but not limited to, fuel, lubricants, vacuum bags, blades, belts, sandpaper, bits, fluids, tune-ups or adjustments;
- e. this warranty will not apply where damage is caused by repairs made or attempted by others (i.e. persons not authorized by the manufacturer);
- f. this warranty will not apply to any product that was sold to the original purchaser as a reconditioned or refurbished product (unless otherwise specified in writing);
- g. this warranty will not apply to any product or part thereof if any part from another manufacturer is installed therein or any repairs or alterations have been made or attempted by unauthorized persons;
- h. this warranty will not apply to normal deterioration of the exterior finish, such as, but not limited to, scratches, dents, paint chips, or to any corrosion or discolouring by heat, abrasive and chemical cleaners; and
- i. this warranty will not apply to component parts sold by and identified as the product of another company, which shall be covered under the product manufacturer's warranty, if any.

Additional Limitations

This warranty applies only to the original purchaser and may not be transferred. Neither the retailer not the manufacturer shall be liable for any other expense, loss or damage, including, without limitation, any indirect, incidental, consequential or exemplary damages arising in connection with the sale, use or inability to use this product.
