




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

4 To make one side of the top half of the storage unit. Fit one short top shelf support and two short standard shelf supports into two keyhole uprights as shown. (Note end profiles.) Fit the TOP support first. It must be located in the top two holes of the upright. Then fit the fourth support. Fit the third support into support

the bottom hole of the upright last. (Pic. 4) Repeat this procedure to make the second side. Fit these two top halves to the bottom half of the unit. (Pic. 4)



5 Fit long shelf supports to the uprights at the third, fourth and top shelf positions. Note: only use long TOP shelf supports for top shelf position. (Pic. 5)





- To reduce the risk of serious injury, read the following safety instructions before assembling and using the product.
- This product is intended for domestic, indoor use only.
- Assemble the unit on a hard and level surface. Never assemble on a carpet.
- Arrange for necessary manpower when assembling and moving the product.
- When using for a mallet, use a cloth or wood block to protect the surface finish of the product. The mallet is NOT included in the package.
- Rivets must sit at the bottom of the keyhole slots. This is accomplished by hitting the flat section of the Z-beam with a mallet.
- Place small, stable items on the top shelves. Heavier and bulkier items should be stored on the lower shelves. Never allow children to climb or hang on shelves.
- It is recommended that wall anchors should be used to secure the shelving unit. The anchors are included in the package.
- Serious or fatal crashing injuries can occur from furniture tipping over. To prevent this, the shelving must be secured to a wall, especially in earthquake-prone environments, where surfaces are uneven, and where children and/or pets are present.
- Different wall materials require different types of fasteners. Use fasteners suitable for your specific type of wall. If you are uncertain about what type of fasteners to use, please contact your local hardware store.
- Do not exceed the following weight limits for this product. o Maximum load: 1650 lb (748 kg)
- o Maximum load for each shelf: 330 lb (150 kg)
- Tools Required for Shelving Assembly: Rubber mallet, power drill, masonry drill bit.





MBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Attach a plastic foot to one end of four of the keyhole uprights. NOTE: Ensure keyholes are the correct way up.




2 Fit two short standard shelf supports and two long standard shelf supports (note end profile) to the bottom holes (for maximum strength) of four keyhole uprights by slotting the keylock pins in the supports into the keyholes in the uprights and tapping firmly with a mallet to position. (Pic. 2)




3 Fit long and short standard shelf supports where you want the second shelf to be positioned. These supports must not be in the top two holes of the keyhole upright.

(We have shelf position recommendations listed below.)


6 Place the 3/8" (9 mm) MDF shelves on the shelf supports.

Take special note of the additional diagrams to the right of Pic. 6.

Fit the remaining four plastic feet to the tops

of the uprights. (Pic. 6) ₱ PLACE 3/8" (9 MM) MDF PLACE 3/8" (9 MM) MDF SHELF HERE STANDARD

7 Use three of the joiners supplied (two supplied with each unit) to join two units together by inserting the joiner into one slot on each of the uprights. Position two on the front uprights and one on the back uprights.



8 Wall Mounting Instructions Note: Drywall anchors and anchor screws are included with this shelving;

however, different wall materials require different types of fasteners. Use fasteners suitable for your specific type of wall. If you are uncertain about what type of fasteners to use, then please contact your local hardware store.

(1) Take the bracket and attach it to the bottom of the long top shelf support (6). (2) Position the shelving so the flat end of the bracket is touching the wall. Use a pencil to mark the location of the two holes on the wall. Use the included drywall anchors, anchor screws, and recommended tools to install the anchor screws. (Pic. 8)
