



- The maximum weight capacity for the loveseat and corner chair is 225 lb (102 kg) per seat; maximum weight capacity for table is 44 lb (20 kg). Do not stand on loveseat, corner chair or side table.
- Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate, or install the product.
- Any assembly or maintenance of the product must be carried out by adults only.
- Some parts may contain sharp edges. Wear protective gloves if necessary.
- To prevent damage, place all parts on a level surface during assembly. Add a layer of protective surface if needed.
- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if this protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.

Place the right arm **3** onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its inside facing upwards. Attach two plastic feet 6 to right arm panel 3 with nuts F, spring washers  ${\bf G}$  and washers  ${\bf H}$  using wrench  ${\bf I}$ , aligning the holes. Repeat step to attach plastic foot 6 to loveseat back-right 1, and to loveseat base-right 2, with nuts F, spring washers **G** and washers **H** using wrench **I**. When assembled, tighten all screws with wrench I.











Place the loveseat back—right **1** onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its inside facing upwards. Attach the loveseat base—right **2** to loveseat back—right **1**, with screws **A**, **C** and washers **D** using hex key **E**, aligning the holes.







#### STEP 3


Place the right arm **3** onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its inside facing upwards. Attach the loveseat base—right **2** and back—right **1** to the right arm **3** with screws **A**, butterfly bolt **B** and washers **D** using hex key **E**, aligning the holes. When assembled, tighten all screws with hex key **E**.





Put seat cushions **4**, back cushions **5** and bolster cushion **10** on the seat.



Place the left arm 9 onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its inside facing upwards. Attach two plastic feet 6 to left arm panel 9 with nuts F, spring washers G and washers **H** using wrench **I**, aligning the holes. Repeat step to attach plastic foot 6 to loveseat back-left 7, and to loveseat base-left 8 with nuts F, spring washers G and washers **H** using wrench **I**. When assembled, tighten all screws with wrench I.











Place the loveseat back—left  $\bf 7$  onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its inside facing upwards. Attach the loveseat base—left  $\bf 8$  to loveseat back—left  $\bf 7$ , with screws  $\bf A$ ,  $\bf C$  and washers  $\bf D$  using hex key  $\bf E$ , aligning the holes.







#### STEP 3


Place the left arm 9 onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its inside facing upwards. Attach the loveseat back—left 7 to the loveseat base—left 8 with screws **A**, butterfly bolt **B** and washers **D** using hex key **E**, aligning the holes. When assembled, tighten all screws with hex key **E**.





Put seat cushions **4**, back cushions **5** and bolster cushion **10** on the seat.




# **STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE**


#### STEP 1

Place the chair base 2 onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its bottom facing upwards. Attach two plastic feet 5 to the chair base 2 with nuts E, spring washers **F** and washers **G** using wrench **H**, aligning the holes. Repeat step to attach plastic feet **5** to chair back  ${f 1}$ . When assembled, tighten all screws with wrench  ${f H}$ .











Place the chair back  ${\bf 1}$  onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its inside facing upwards. Attach the chair base  ${\bf 2}$  to chair back  ${\bf 1}$  with screws  ${\bf B}$  and washers  ${\bf C}$  using hex hey  ${\bf D}$ , aligning the holes.




# STEP 3

Attach the chair base 2 to chair back 1 with screws A and washers  ${f C}$  using hex hey  ${f D}$ , aligning the holes. When assembled, tighten all screws with hex key **D**.





# NOTE:

Do not fully tighten screws until you have assembled the chair. Once assembly is complete, then fully tighten each screw.




Put seat cushion **3** and back cushions **4** on the chair.






# **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

When in use, the loveseats and corner chair can be connected using  ${\bf 2}$  plastic connectors  ${\bf I}$  on each side.





# **STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE**

#### STEP 1

Attach the side panel 8 to the side panels 7 with screws I and washers C using hex key D, aligning the holes.

When assembled, tighten all screws with hex key **D**.









# **STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE**

#### STEP 3

Place the side panel onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet. Attach the bottom panel  $\bf 9$  to table side panels  $\bf 8$  with screws  $\bf I$  and washers  $\bf C$  using hex key  $\bf D$ . aligning the holes. When assembled, tighten all screws with hex key  $\bf D$ .








Set table upright and put table feet on the floor, then place the table top **6** on the top.





# STEP 6

Repeat Steps 1-5 to assemble the other side table.



# **CARING FOR YOUR ITEM**

• The cushion may be washed on the surface only by using mild soap and water or commercial foaming upholstery cleaner if necessary. If washed, rinse well and hang to dry. Do not machine wash or dry.

**OFF SEASON:** Clean and dry before storing in a dry, sheltered area.
