





























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- SET UP YOUR FURNITURE PROPERLY

Ensure that all parts are assembled properly and fully tightened as per the instructions. When placing in the desired location, ensure that all legs are resting on the same surface. You may adjust the legs levellers as required to ensure that the item stands in a rigid position.
- EXAMINE YOUR FURNITURE

Examine occasionally to ensure that there are no loose parts. If loose parts are found, they must be retightened fully before additional use.
- Do not completely tighten bolts and nuts until indicated in assembly step.

IMPORTANT: Retain for future reference, and read carefully.

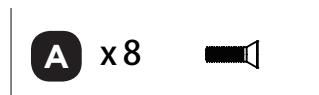

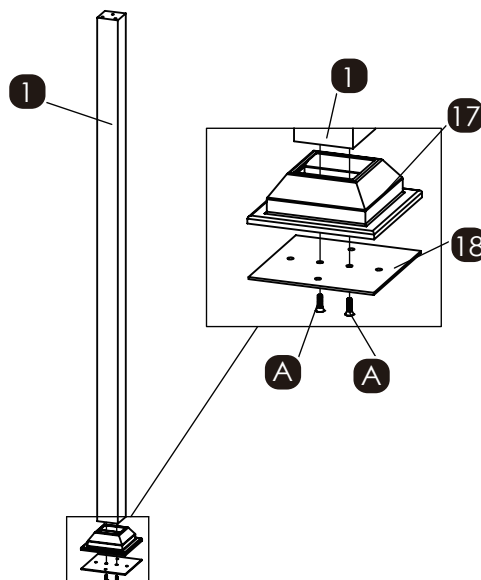
## Step 1

**Requires 1, 17, 18, A.**

Insert two bolts **A** through the base plate **18** and post base **17**, and secure into the leg post **1**. Tighten completely. Repeat procedure for the remaining three legs. **Note:** The side of base plate with sunk hole should be towards outside and the bolt should be level with the base plate.



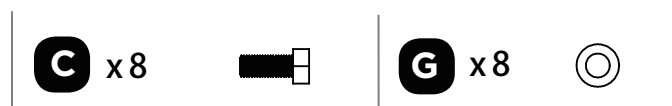
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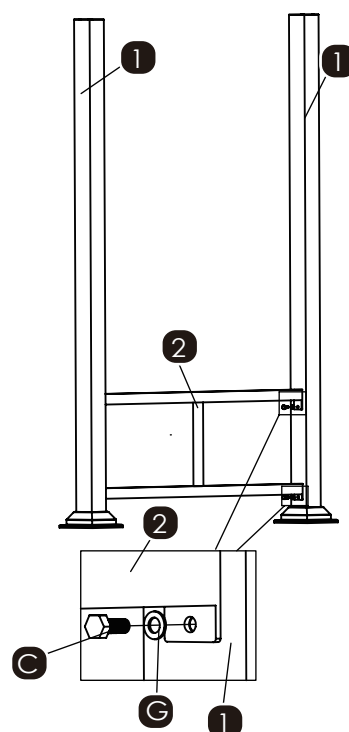
## Step 2

**Requires 1, 2, C, G.**

Attach the side panel **2** to two legs **1** by inserting a bolt **C** through a metal washer **G**, through the hole of the side panel **2**, and secure into the leg **1**. Repeat procedure for the other side. Do not tighten completely. Repeat procedure for the other side panel.



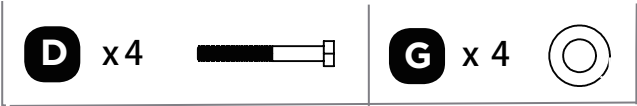
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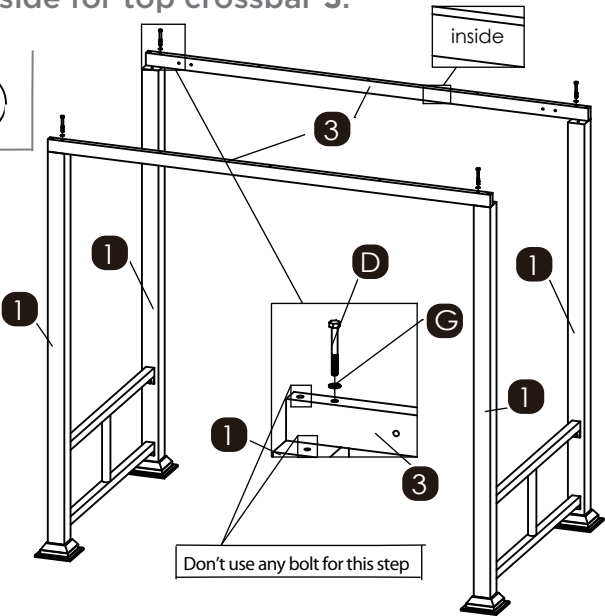
Step 3

Requires 1, 3, D, G.

Attach the top crossbar 3 to the leg 1. Insert a bolt D through a metal washer G, through the top crossbar 3 and secure into the leg post 1. Do not tighten completely. Repeat procedure for the remaining three legs. Note: The side with “inside” label should be towards inside for top crossbar 3.



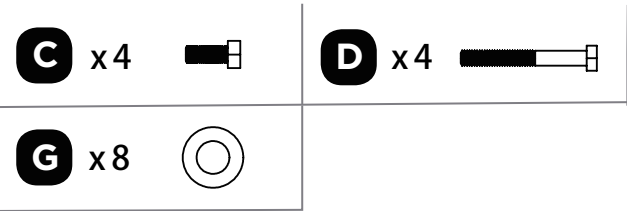
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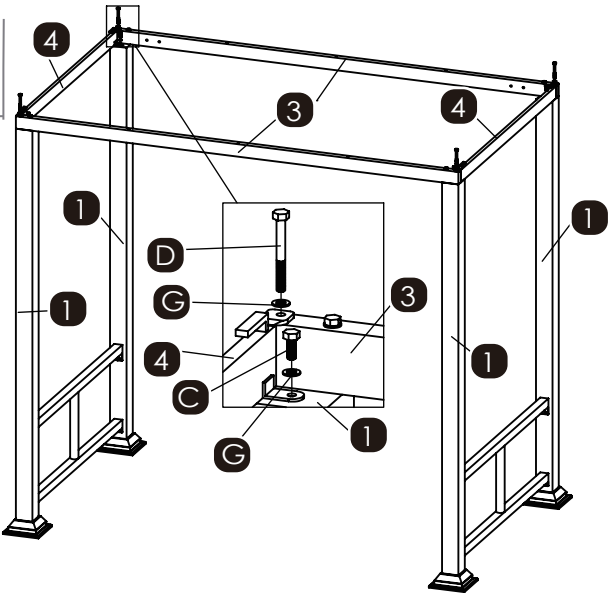
Step 4

Requires 1, 3, 4, C, D, G.

Attach the top crossbar 4 to assembled frame 1 & 3 & 4. First insert a bolt D through a metal washer G, through the top crossbar 4, through the top crossbar 3 and secure into the leg post 1. Second, insert a bolt C through a metal washer G, through the top crossbar 4 and secure into the leg post 1. Do not tighten completely. Repeat procedure for the remaining three legs.



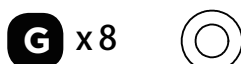
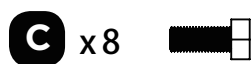
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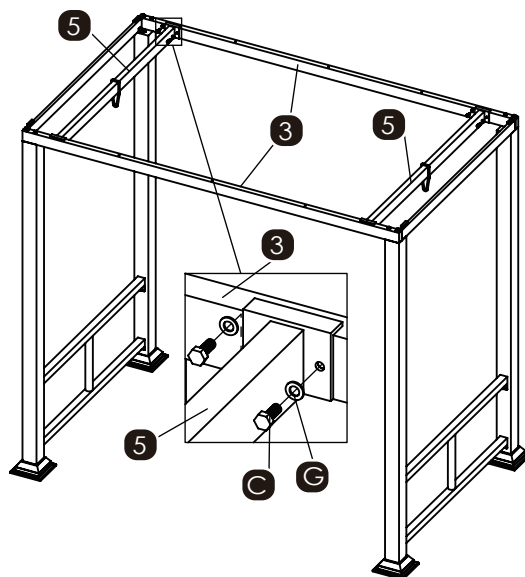
## Step 5

### Requires 3, 5, C, G.

Attach top crossbar 5 to the top crossbars 3. Insert a bolt C through a metal washer G, then through the bracket on the top crossbar 5, and secure into the top crossbar 3. Do not tighten completely. Repeat procedure for the other side and other top crossbar 5.



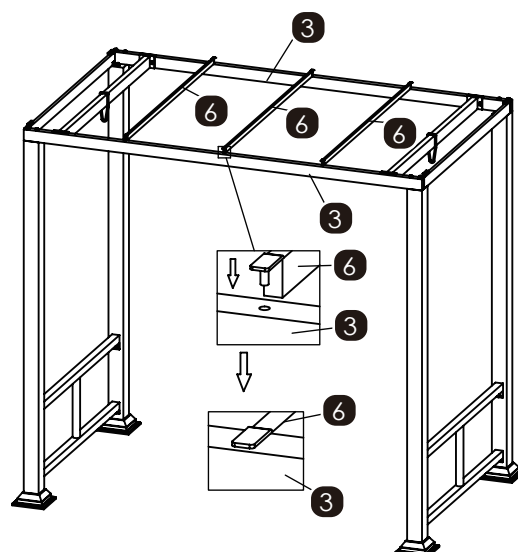
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## Step 6

### Requires 3, 6.

Attach the canopy bar 6 to the top crossbar 3. Insert the canopy bar 6 into the holes on the top crossbar 3. Note: Two sides of the canopy crossbar insert into top crossbar at the same time. Repeat procedure for the other two canopy crossbars 6.



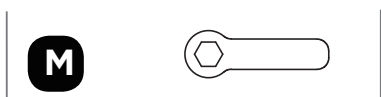
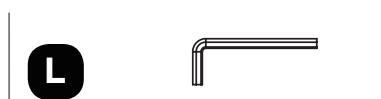
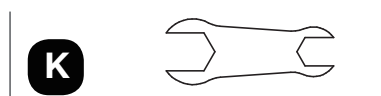
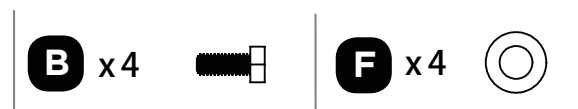
## Step 7

Requires **2, 7, B, F, K, L, M.**

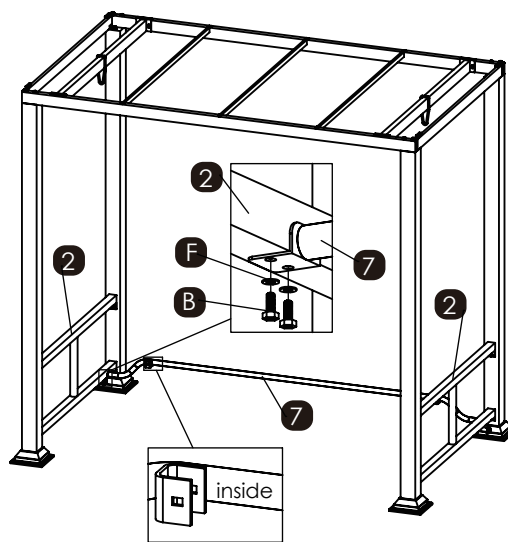
Place the rear crossbar **7** between the side panels **2**. Insert a bolt **B** through a metal washer **F**, through the rear crossbar **7**, and secure into the side panel **2**. Do not tighten completely. Repeat procedure for the other side.

Tighten all bolts from step 1 to step 7 by using the wrenches provided.

Note: The side with “inside” label and “U” shaped brackets should be towards inside for the rear crossbar **7**.



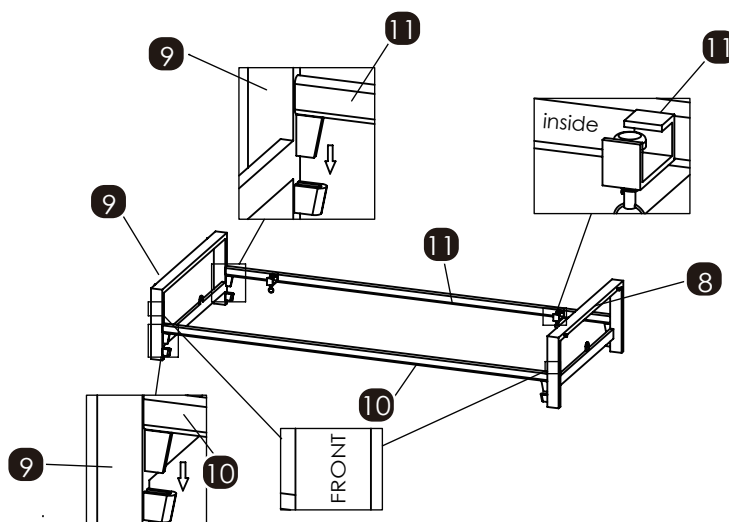
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## Step 8

Requires **8, 9, 10, 11.**

Lay out the right arm **9**, left arm **8**, front support bar **10** and rear support bar **11**. Make sure that the labels marked “FRONT” on the arms and support bars are all facing the front edge of the seat. Attach the seat support bars to the arms by pressing the tabs on the ends of the front support bar **10** and rear support bar **11**, down into the brackets on the arms. Make sure they are securely seated.

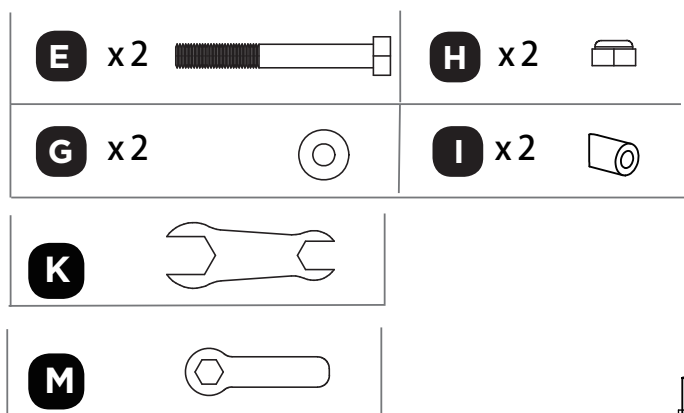




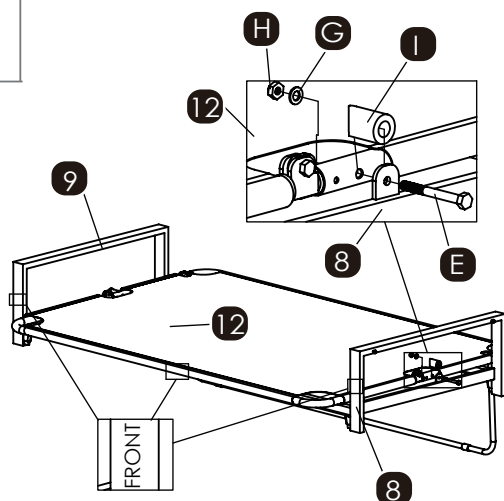
## Step 9

**Requires 8, 9, 12, E, G, H, I, K, M.**

Unfold the seat and back 12 and lay it on top of the assembled frame. Line up the holes. Insert a bolt E (from outside to inside) through the bracket of the arm, through a plastic washer I, through the side bar on the seat and back 12, through a metal washer G and secure with a nut H. Do not tighten completely. Repeat procedure for the other side. Then securely tighten all bolts and nuts for this step.



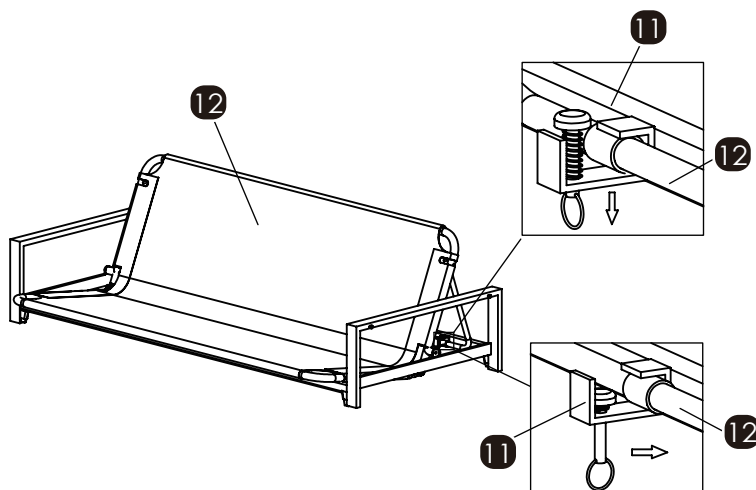
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## Step 10

**Requires 11, 12.**

Put up the back and pull down the pin on the U-shaped bracket on the rear support bar 11 then slip the support tube on the back into the U-shaped bracket in place per drawing.



## Step 11

**Requires 5, 8, 9, 13, J, N.**

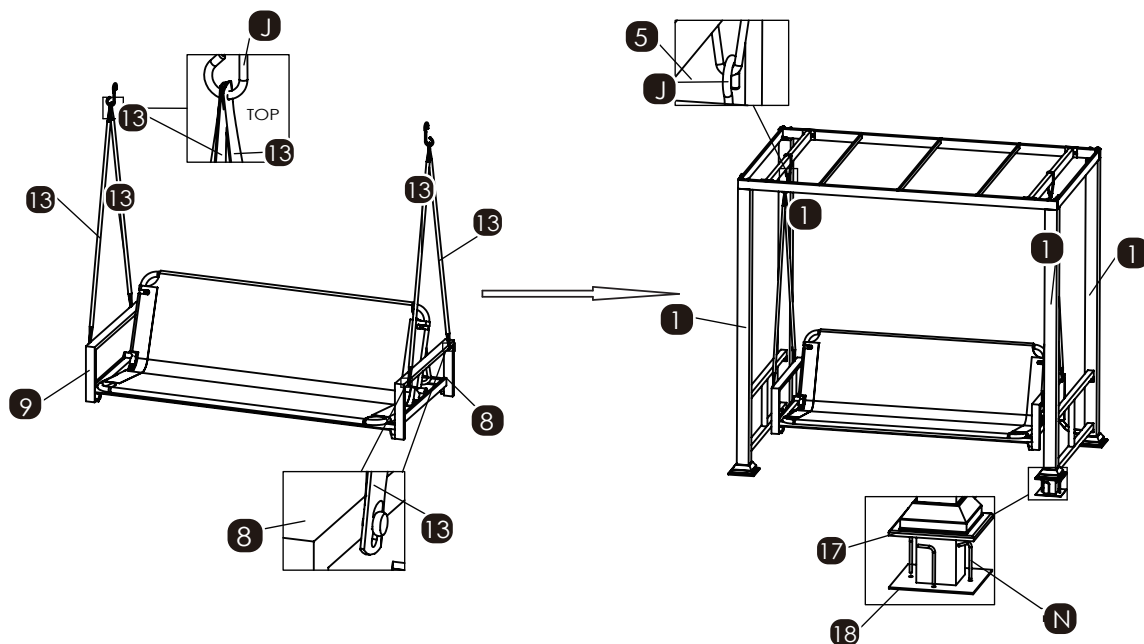
First, set the hanging bars **13** into “S” hook. Note: the side with “TOP” label towards “S” hook. Then the other ends of hanging bars into the pin of the arms. Repeat procedure for the other remaining two hanging bars.

Second, hang the assembled body on the top crossbars **5**.

Third, secure the lawn stack **N** into the ground. Repeat procedure for the other three post legs.



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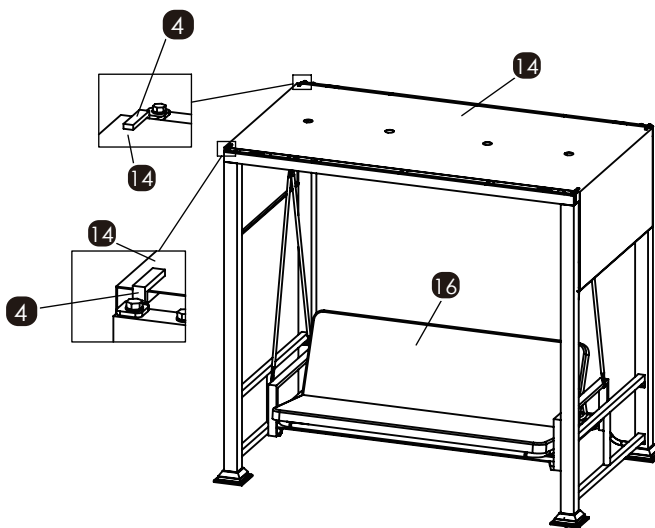


## Step 12

**Requires 4, 14, 16.**

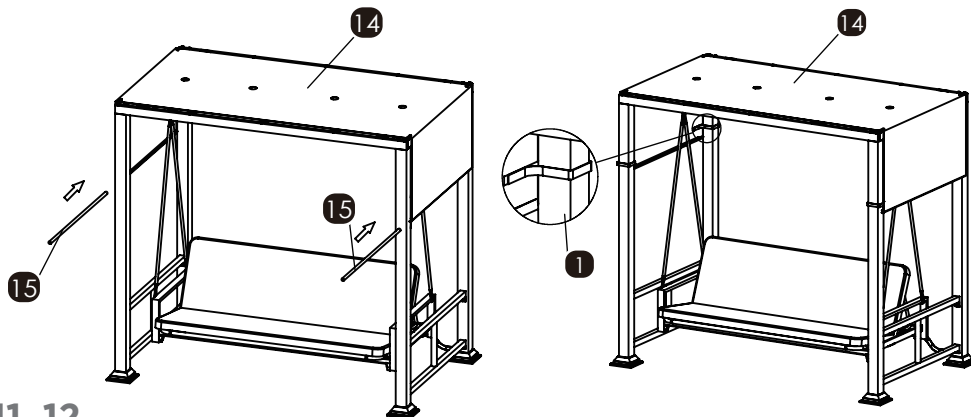
Place the canopy **14** and cushion **16** on the swing as per drawing.

Note: the canopy should place under the bracket.



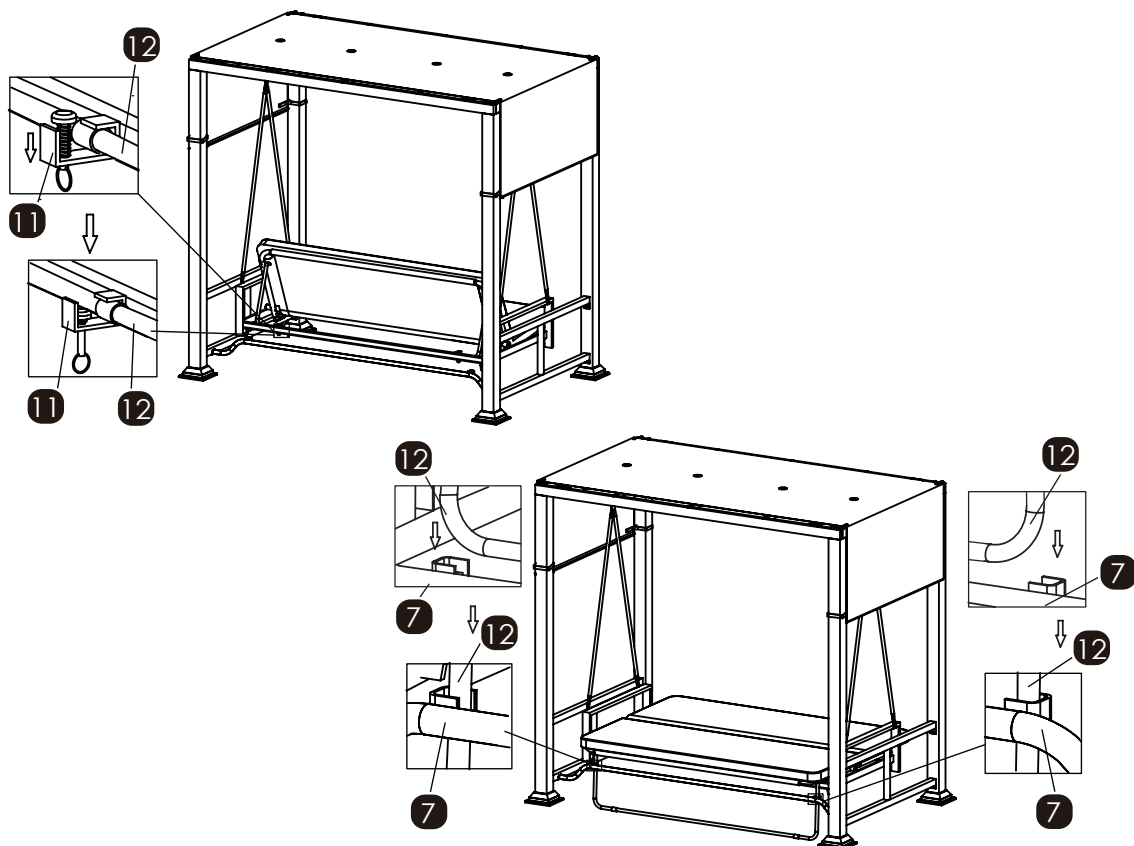
**Step 13****Requires 1, 14, 15.**

Insert the canopy side bar 15 into the canopy 14 as per drawing.  
Fasten the ties attached to the canopy 14 to each leg post 1.

**Step 14****Requires 7, 11, 12.**

To convert the swing into a hanging bed, first push down the pin on rear support bar 11. Second take out the back support tube from U-shaped bracket on the rear support bar. Repeat procedure for the other side. Third, set the support tube on the back into the U-shaped bracket on the rear crossbar 7 per drawing. Repeat procedure for the other side.

When used as a bed, the seat assembly should be secured by these holders and not allowed to swing.

- Though its powder-coated finish is rust-resistant, steel is prone to rust over time with exposure to the elements. In case of rust or scratches, lightly sand the affected area and apply touch-up paint. To maintain the finish, periodically apply wax with a soft cloth.
- Wash frames with a mild solution of soap and water; rinse thoroughly. Do not use bleach or solvents.
- **CARING FOR OUTDOOR FURNITURE WITH CUSHIONS:**  
Wash frames and cushions with a mild solution of soap and water; rinse thoroughly. Dry frame completely and allow cushions to drip-dry. Do not use bleach or solvents.

**WARRANTY**

This CANVAS product carries a one (1) year warranty against defects in workmanship and materials.
