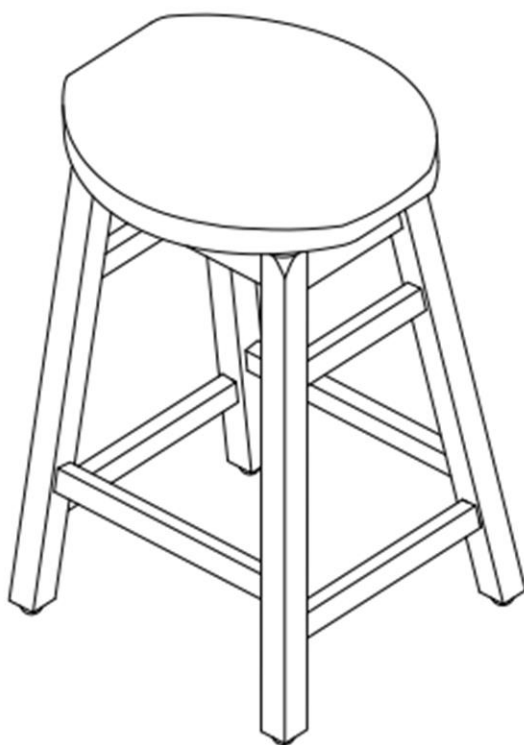

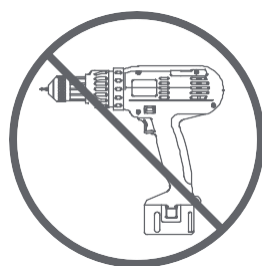

- Any assembly or maintenance of the product must be carried out by adults only.
- Some parts may contain sharp edges. Wear protective gloves if necessary.
- To prevent damage, place all parts on a level surface during assembly. Add a layer of protective surface if needed.
- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if the protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize the condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN ASSEMBLY

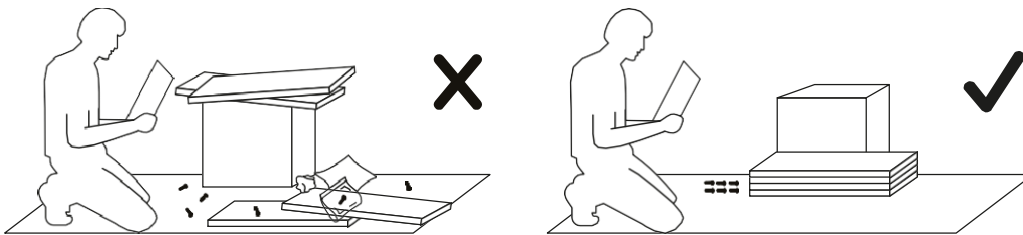
MAKE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT

Compare all pieces to the parts and hardware lists, and make sure you have all tools required for assembly.



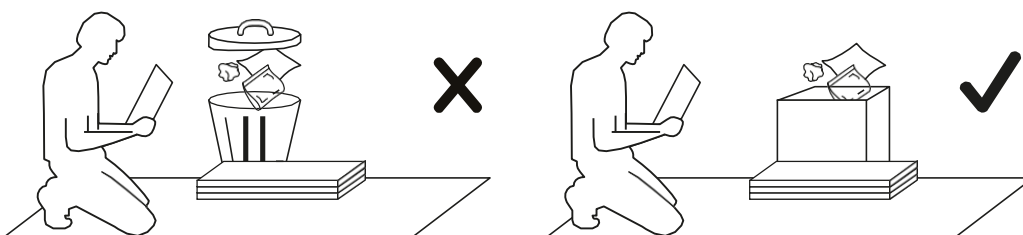
ASSEMBLE IN A CLEARED AREA

Place all parts from the box on the floor in front of you on a clean, dry, level surface to protect the product as it is being built.



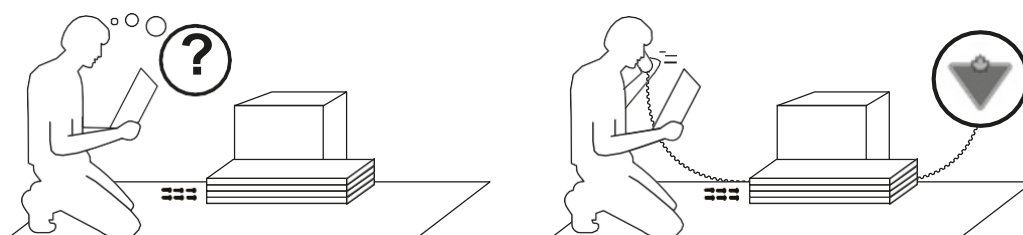
REMOVE PACKAGING MATERIALS

Place packaging materials back in the box. Do not dispose of packaging materials until assembly is complete.



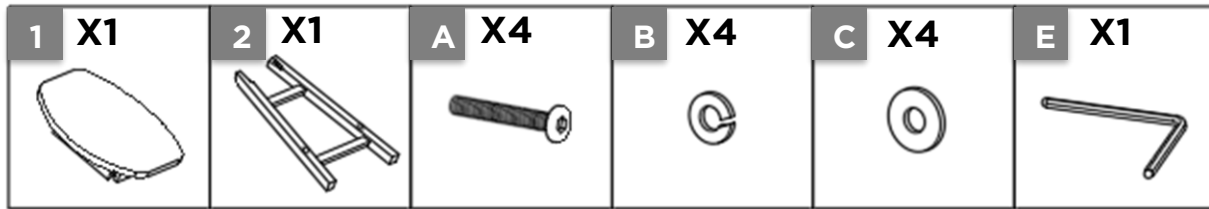

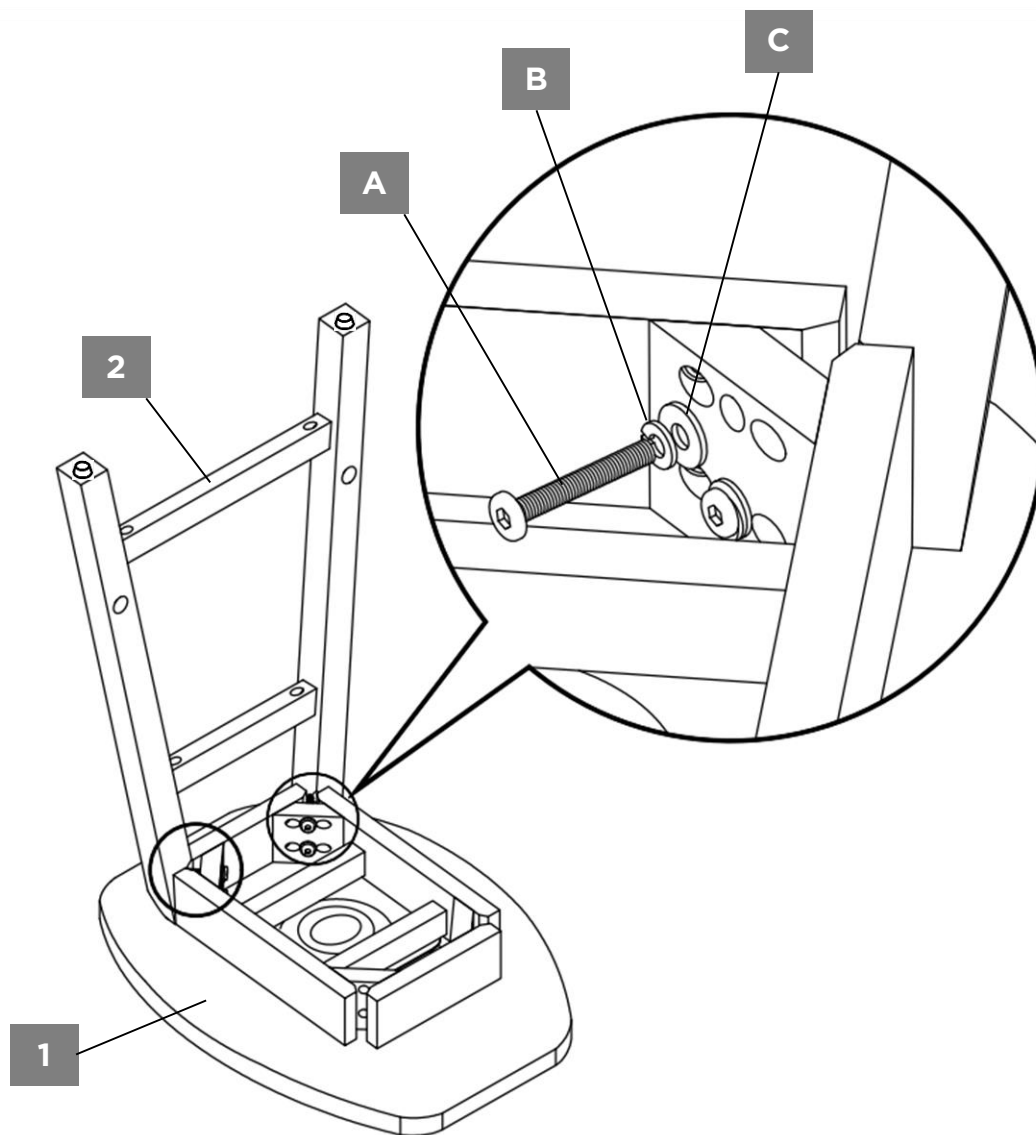
STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

STEP 1



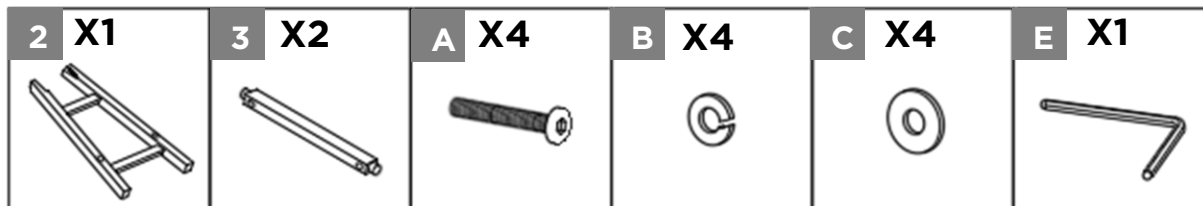
Put seat surface **1** (top towards the ground) on a clean and flat surface/floor, then attach leg frame **2** to seat surface **1** using bolt **A**, spring washer **B** and washer **C**, aligning the holes. Repeat for other leg frame.

When assembled, tighten all the bolts with the hex key **E**.



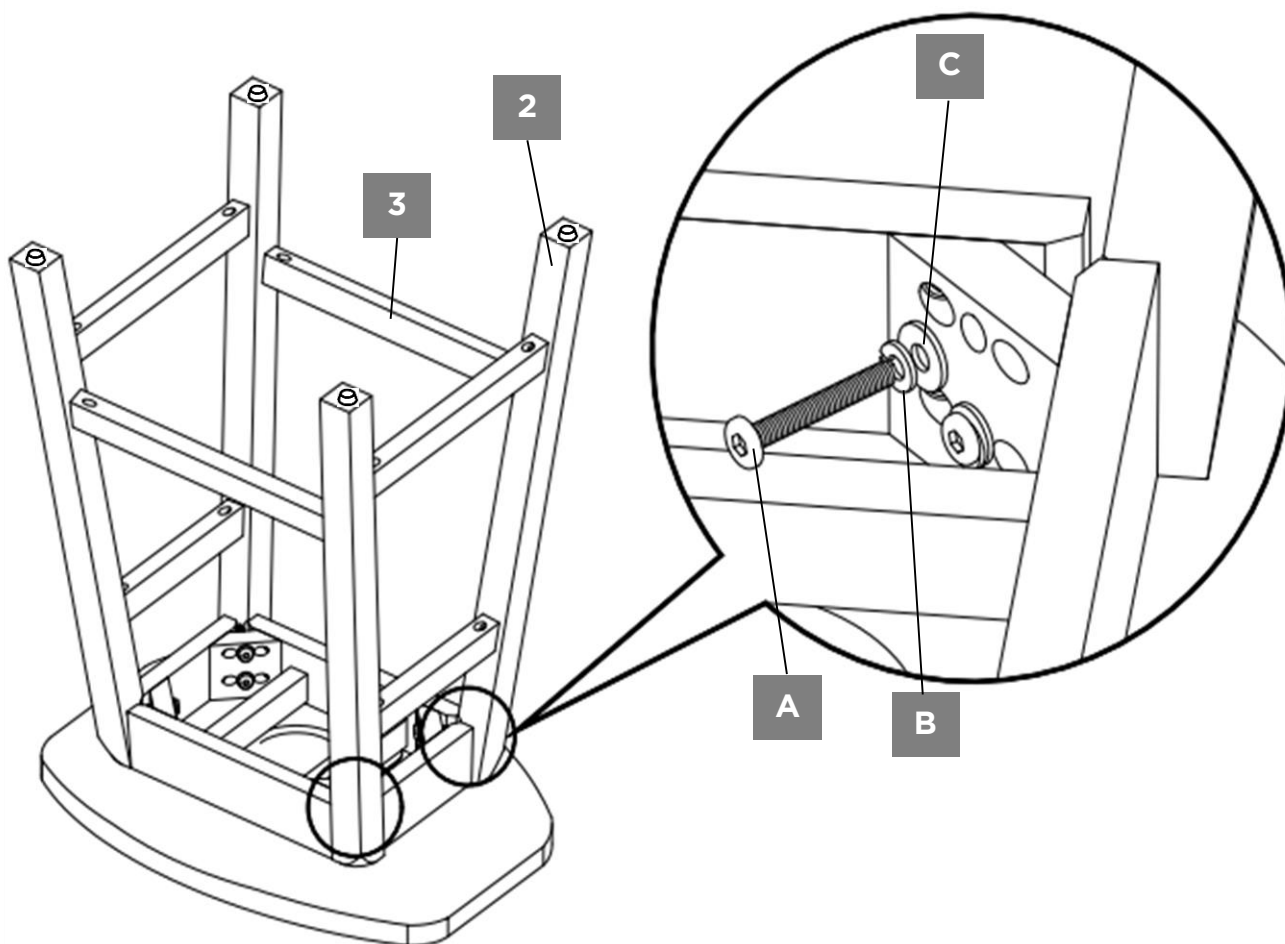
STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

STEP 2



Attach support bar **3** to leg frame by inserting tenon into mortise and aligning the holes. Repeat for other support bar.

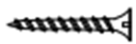
When assembled, tighten all the bolts with the hex key **E**.



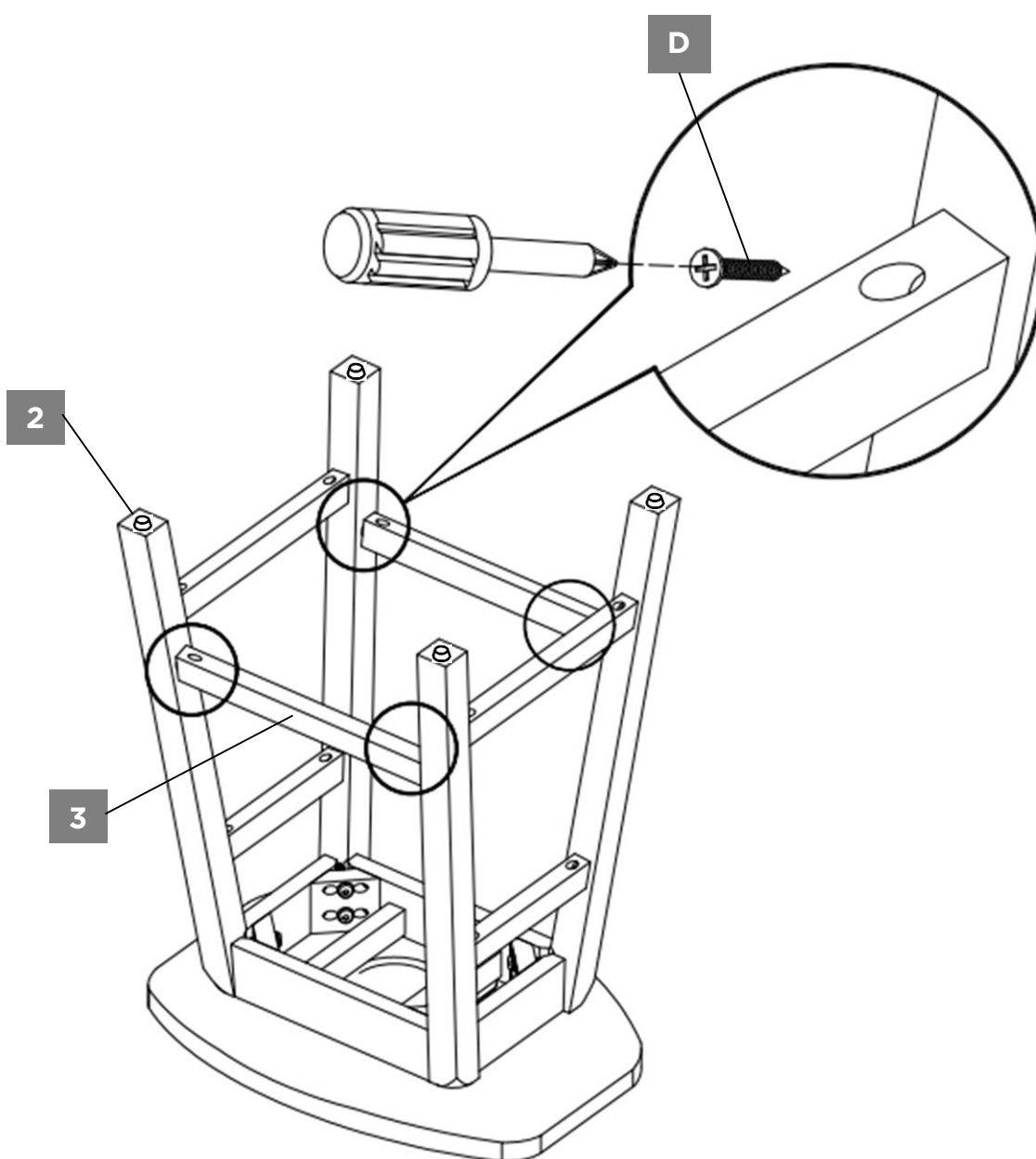

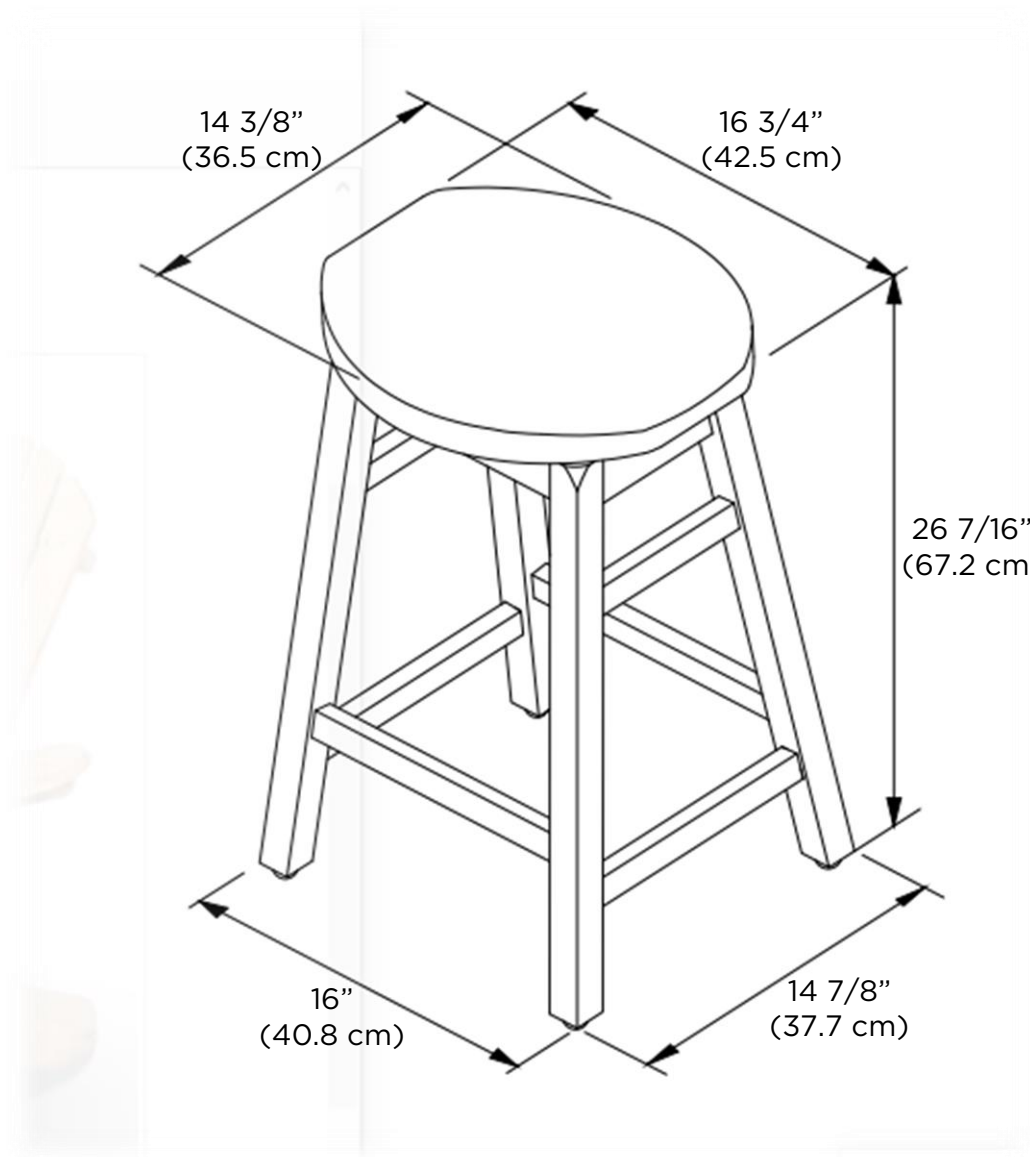

Affix support bars **3** to leg frame using screw **B** and cross-head screwdriver (not included); do not tighten the screw too tightly and do not use an electric tool.
