



- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if this protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.





Compare all pieces to the parts and hardware lists, and make sure you have all tools required for assembly.




ASSEMBLE IN A CLEARED AREA

Place all parts from the box on the floor in front of you on a clean, dry, level surface to protect the product as it is being built.




REMOVE PACKAGING MATERIALS

Place packing materials back in the box. Do not dispose of packaging materials until assembly is complete.




STEP 1




Slides must be separated before assembly.

After separated, set aside until needed for assembly.


Push lever up, then remove runner.






Attach four cam bolts **B** to drawer front panel **16**. Do not over-tighten. Insert two wood dowels C to drawer left panel 17 and drawer right panel 18.

Attach drawer left panel 17, drawer right panel 18 and drawer bottom support 21 to drawer front panel 16 using four cam locks M. Tighten cam locks M. Cover cam locks M using four coated paper stickers P on drawer left panel 17 and drawer right panel 18.





STEP 3



Attach drawer back panel 19 to drawer left panel 17, drawer right panel 18 and drawer bottom support **21** using six screws **N**.

Attach two 10" slides I to drawer left panel 17, drawer right panel 18 using three screws L each.







Attach six cam bolts **B** to drawer front panel **22**. Do not over-tighten.

Attach drawer left panel **23**, drawer right panel **24** and drawer bottom support **27** to drawer front panel **22** using six cam locks **M**. Tighten cam locks **M**. Cover cam locks **M** using four coated paper stickers **P** on drawer left panel **23** and drawer right panel **24**.

Insert drawer bottom 26 as shown.





STEP 5



Attach drawer back panel 25 to drawer left panel 23, drawer right panel 24 and drawer bottom support $\bf 27$ using six screws $\bf N$.


Attach two 12" slides $\bf J$ to drawer left panel $\bf 23$ and drawer right panel $\bf 24$ using three screws $oldsymbol{\mathsf{L}}$ each.






Attach 16 cam bolts **B** to left panel **3** and right panel **4**. Do not over-tighten.

Insert eight wood dowels **C** to left panel **3** and right panel **4**.




STEP 7




Attach two 10" slides ${f I}$ and two 12" slides ${f J}$ to left panel ${f 3}$ and right panel ${f 4}$ using three screws **L** each.

Make sure slide's open end and slide roller faces the same direction.




STEP 8




Attach two cam bolts **B** to fixed shelf **9**. Do not over-tighten.

Insert 19 wood dowels **C** to left back panel **5** and right back panel **6** and middle partition **11**.






Attach fixed shelf 8 to left panel 3 using two cam locks A. Tighten cam locks A.

Attach fixed shelf 9 to left panel 3 using two cam locks A. Tighten cam locks A, then cover cam locks **A** using two coated paper stickers **P** on fixed shelf **9**.




STEP 10




Attach left back panel ${\bf 5}$ to left panel ${\bf 3}$ using four cam locks ${\bf A}$. Tighten cam locks ${\bf A}$.

Attach left back panel $\bf 5$ to fixed shelf $\bf 9$ using screw $\bf X$.

Insert cam bolt **Y** to left back panel **5**.





STEP 11



Attach right back panel 6 to left back panel 5 using two cam locks A. Tighten cam locks **A**.


Attach right back panel 6 to fixed shelf 9 using screw X.






Attach right panel $\bf 4$ to fixed shelf $\bf 8$ and fixed shelf $\bf 9$ using four cam locks $\bf A$. Tighten cam locks $\bf A$. (If there is not enough space to use screwdriver, you can use hex key $\bf K$ to tighten cam locks $\bf A$.)


Cover cam locks **A** using two coated paper stickers **P** on fixed shelf **9**.




STEP 13



Attach right panel ${f 4}$ to right back panel ${f 6}$ using four cam locks ${f A}$. Tighten cam locks **A**.




STEP 14




Attach eight cam bolts **B** to top panel **1**. Do not over-tighten.

Attach top panel **1** to left panel **3** and right panel **4** using four cam locks **A**. Tighten cam locks **A**.


Cover cam locks **A** using four coated paper stickers **P**.




STEP 15




Attach top panel 1 to left back panel 5 and right back panel 6 using four cam locks **A**. Tighten cam locks **A**.




STEP 16



Insert 12 wood dowels **C** to front apron **12**, left apron **13**, right apron **14** and back apron 15, then attach front apron 12, left apron 13, right apron 14 and back apron 15 together as shown.





STEP 17



Attach 10 cam bolts **B** to bottom panel **2**. Do not over-tighten.


Attach front apron 12, left apron 13, right apron 14 and back apron 15 to bottom panel 2 using 10 cam locks A. Tighten cam locks A.






Attach four adjustable levellers ${\bf Q}$ using four screws ${\bf L}$ each.

Attach 10 cam bolts **B** to bottom panel **2**. Do not over-tighten.




STEP 19



Attach middle partition 11 to fixed shelf 9 using two cam locks A. Tighten cam locks A.


Attach bottom panel 2 to middle partition 11, left panel 3 and right panel 4 using six cam locks A. Tighten cam locks A.

Cover cam locks **A** using eight coated paper stickers **P**.







Attach bottom panel 2 to left back panel 5 and right back panel 6 using four cam locks **A**. Tighten cam locks **A**.




Pull the inner ball bearing slide on each side all the way out till it stops (may be slightly greasy).

Insert drawers as shown.








Attach six hinges ${\bf D}$ to left door ${\bf 28}$ and right door ${\bf 29}$ using two screws ${\bf E}$ each.

Attach two handle **F** to left door **28** and right door **29** using two bolts **G** each.




STEP 23




Attach left door 28 to left panel 3 using 12 screws E.

Attach right door 29 to right panel 4 using 12 screws E.









Insert 16 shelf supports **R** into corresponding holes in left panel **3** and right panel 4, then place two adjustable shelves 7 and two adjustable shelves 10 as shown.

Place four door bumpers **H** to fixed shelf **8** and fixed shelf **9** as shown.



TIP RESTRAINT


STEP 25



Pick your desired area of placement. Drill two small holes approximately 3/8" (9.5 mm) in diameter and approximately 2" (5 cm) deep. Use a level to make sure the two holes you drill are level. After you drill the holes, insert wall anchors ${f V}$ into wall.

Attach metal brackets **U** to wall using screws **S**.

Attach metal brackets **U** to top panel **1** using screws **T**.






Caution! If installing the unit on drywall or other hollow wall applications, the metal bracket must be fastened to studs, headers, or other structural wall supports. The included anchors are intended for use with solid wall applications only (tile or concrete).

DO NOT USE WITH DRYWALL OR OTHER HOLLOW WALL APPLICATIONS.


STEP 26





Attach cabinet to wall using two nylon straps ${f W}$ as shown.






(front view)

Loosen "A" screws.

Adjust door.

Tighten "A" screws.

If there is a gap between doors:

Loosen "C" screw.

Turn "B" to move door.

Tighten "C" screw.

If there is a gap between door and panel:


Loosen "B" and "C" screw.

Adjust door.


Tighten "B" and "C" screw.
