Before You Begin Assembly

Make Sure All Parts Are Present

Compare all pieces to the parts and hardware lists, and make sure you have all tools required for assembly.



Assemble in a Cleared Area

Place all parts from the box on the floor in front of you on a clean, dry, level surface to protect the product as it is being built.




Remove Packaging Materials





Before You Begin Assembly




<u>NOTE:</u> IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO USE GLUE WITH DOWELS. EXCESS GLUE CAN BE WIPED OFF WITH DAMP CLOTH.


Insert the dowel at least half way by tapping lightly with a rubber mallet IF NECESSARY.







CAM LOCK SYSTEM OPERATION



HOW THE KNOCK DOWN (KD) ASSEMBLY SYSTEM WORKS


- 1. Screw the cam bolt into the pre-drilled threaded holes on the panel. Connect both panels together making sure cam bolt goes into the pre-drilled large hole on the end of panel that will accommodate the cam lock.
- 2. Insert the cam lock into the pre-drilled large hole on the panel. Make sure the arrow on the face of cam lock faces out and points towards cam bolt.
- 3. Take a cross-head screwdriver and rotate the cam lock clockwise to lock the cam bolt in place.

SPECIAL NOTE

Please read the instruction sheets completely before assembly. Examine all packaging material before discarding carton. Remove all parts from carton and separate into groups as indicated on parts list. Please ensure all parts are included prior to assembly. Use of power tools to complete assembly is not recommended.


You are now ready to assemble the KD unit.

Step 1




Attach 12 cam bolts (B) to left side panel (3) and right side panel (4). Do not over-tighten.

Insert 16 wood dowels (C) into left side panel (3), right side panel (4) and back panel (6).






Step 2




Attach 14 cam bolts (B) to top panel (1) and bottom panel (2). Do not over-tighten.


Insert four wood dowels (C) into fixed shelf (5).



Step 3




Insert 12 wood dowels (C) into back bottom rail (7), left bottom rail (8), right bottom rail (9) and front bottom rail (10).






Step 4




Attach back bottom rail (7), left bottom rail (8), right bottom rail (9) and front bottom rail (10) together.


Attach bottom panel (2) to back bottom rail (7), left bottom rail (8), right bottom rail (9) and front bottom rail (10) using eight cam locks (A). Tighten cam locks (A).



Step 5




Attach four adjustable levellers (J) using four screws (K) each.







Step 6



Attach six cam bolts (B) to bottom panel (2).




Step 7




Attach left side panel (3) and right side panel (4) to fixed shelf (5) and back panel (6) using four cam locks (A). Tighten cam locks (A).

Cover cam locks (A) using four coated paper stickers (I).






Step 8




Attach top panel (1) and bottom panel (2) to left side panel (3) and right side panel (4) using eight cam locks (A). Tighten cam locks (A).

Cover cam locks (A) using eight coated paper stickers (I).




Step 9



Move the unit to its upright position. Then attach top panel (1), bottom panel (2), left side panel (3) and right side panel (4) to back panel (6) using 12 cam locks (A). Tighten cam locks (A).


Cover cam locks (A) using twelve coated paper stickers (I).








Step 10




Attach three hinges (D) to door (12) using two screws (E) each.

Attach handle (H) to door (12) using two bolts (G).




Attach door (12) to right side panel (4) using 12 screws (E).








Step 12




Insert 16 shelf supports (F) into corresponding holes in left side panel (3) and right side panel (4), then place four adjustable shelves (11) as shown.



Tip Restraint

Step 13



Pick your desired area of placement. Drill two small holes approximately 3/8" (9.5 mm) in diameter and approximately 2" (5 cm) deep. Use a level to make sure the two holes are level. After you drill the holes, insert wall anchors (**O**) into wall.

Attach metal brackets (N) to wall using screws (L).

Attach metal brackets (N) to top panel (1) using screws (M).



Caution! If installing the unit on drywall or other hollow wall applications, the metal bracket must be fastened to studs, headers, or other structural wall supports. The included anchors are intended for use with solid wall applications only (tile or concrete).

DO NOT USE WITH DRYWALL OR OTHER HOLLOW WALL APPLICATIONS.




Attach cabinet to wall using two nylon straps (P) as shown.




Warning! To reduce the risk of serious injury and avoid the potential for furniture tipping over, install the tip restraint hardware.



Adjust Door






(front view)

If doors are not aligned:

Loosen "A" screws. Adjust door. Tighten "A" screws. If there is a gap between doors:


Loosen "C" screw. Turn "B" to move door. Tighten "C" screw. If there is a gap between door and side panel:

Loosen "B" and "C" screw. Adjust door. Tighten "B" and "C" screw.

door from right panel.




Adjust Levellers
