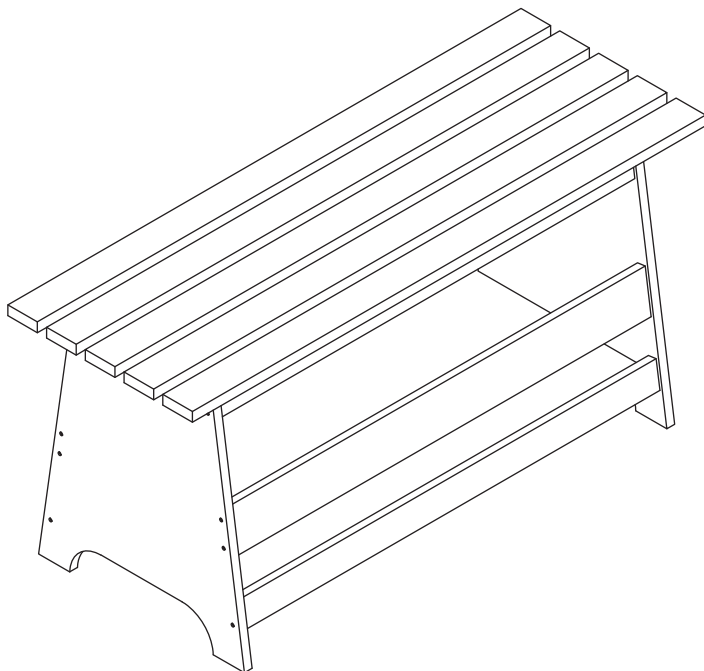

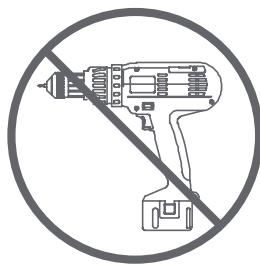

- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if the protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.

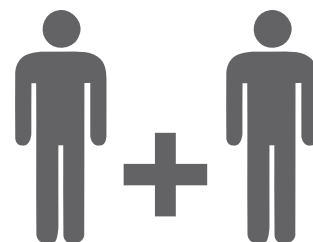

Tip Shown Actual Size







Be aware of over-drilling.

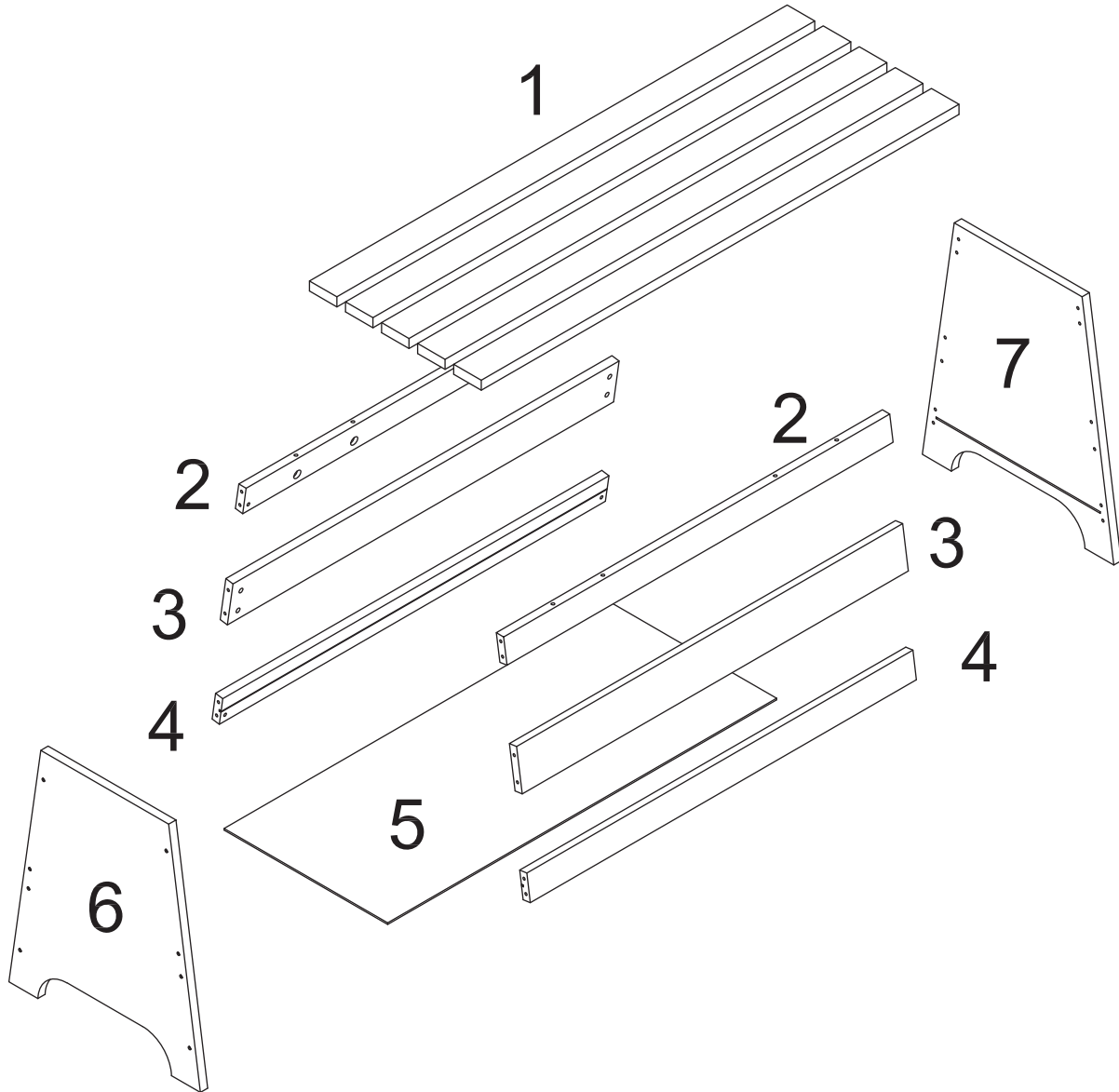



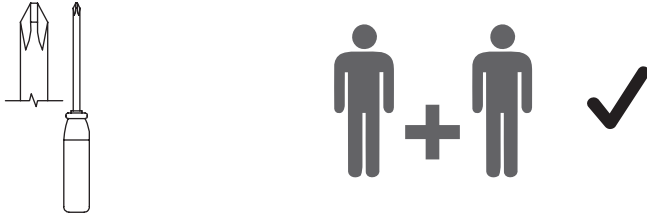

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN ASSEMBLY

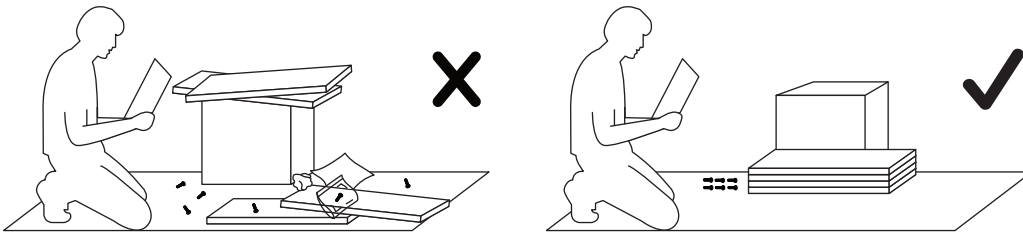
### MAKE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT

Compare all pieces to the parts and hardware lists, and make sure you have all tools required for assembly.



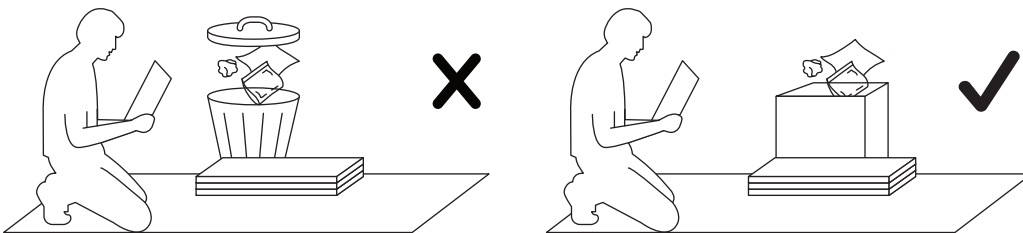
### ASSEMBLE IN A CLEARED AREA

Place all parts from the box on the floor in front of you on a clean, dry, level surface to protect the product as it is being built.



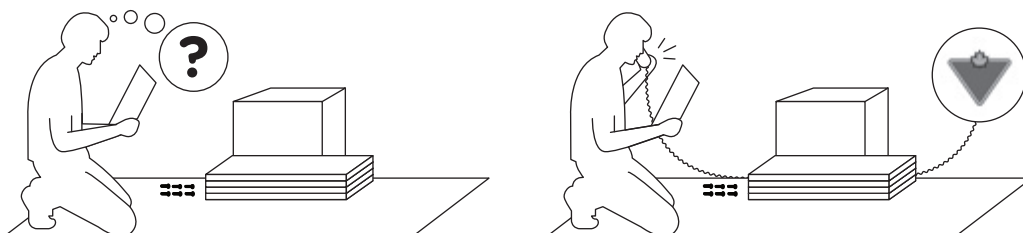
### REMOVE PACKAGING MATERIALS

Place packing materials back in the box. Do not dispose of packaging materials until assembly is complete.



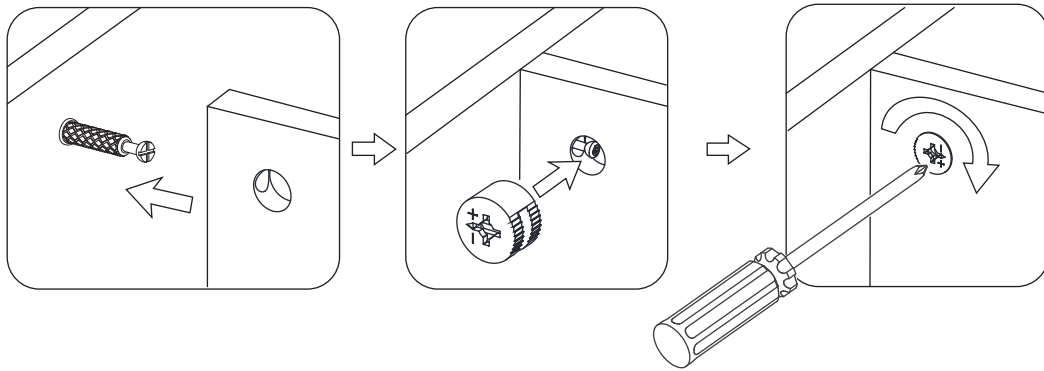

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN ASSEMBLY

### CAM LOCK SYSTEM OPERATION











1. Screw cam bolt into the pre-drilled small holes on panel. Align the panels to be joined so that the cam bolt goes into the pre-drilled hole on the edge of the second panel and protrudes into the hole that will house the cam lock.
2. Insert the cam lock into pre-drilled large hole on panel. Make sure arrow on the cam lock is pointed toward the cam bolt.
3. Once the cam bolt is connected inside cam lock, take a cross-head screwdriver and tighten the cam lock by turning clockwise.

You are now ready to assemble the product.

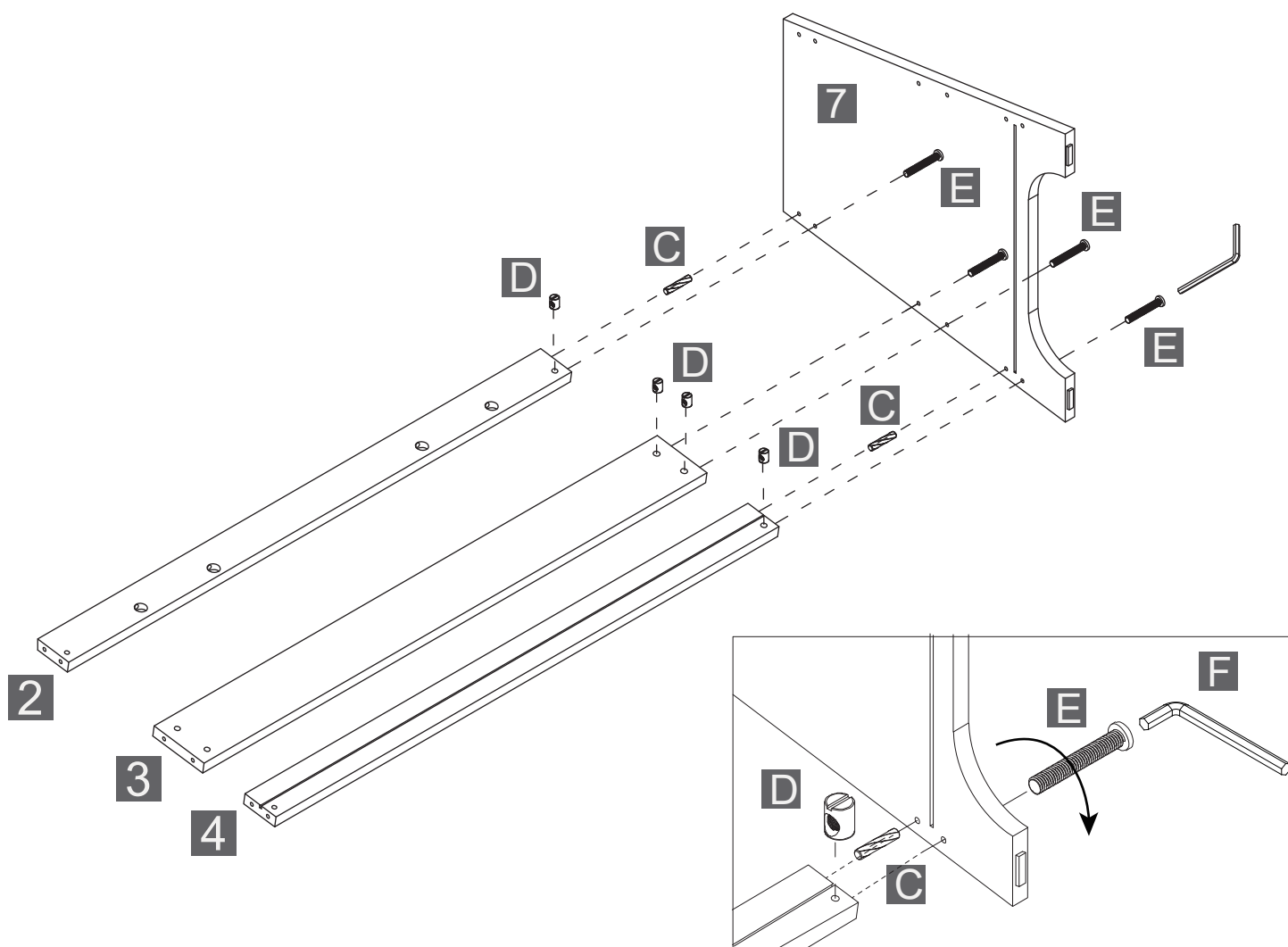

Insert two wood dowels **C** into support bar **2**, cross bar **3** and cross bar **4**. Align and insert the wood dowels into the holes on right side panel **7** as shown. Insert four barrel nuts **D** into the holes of support bar **2**, upper cross bar **3** and lower cross bar **4**. Affix support bar **2**, upper cross bar **3** and lower cross bar **4** to right side panel **7** using four bolts **E**. Tighten using hex key **F**.

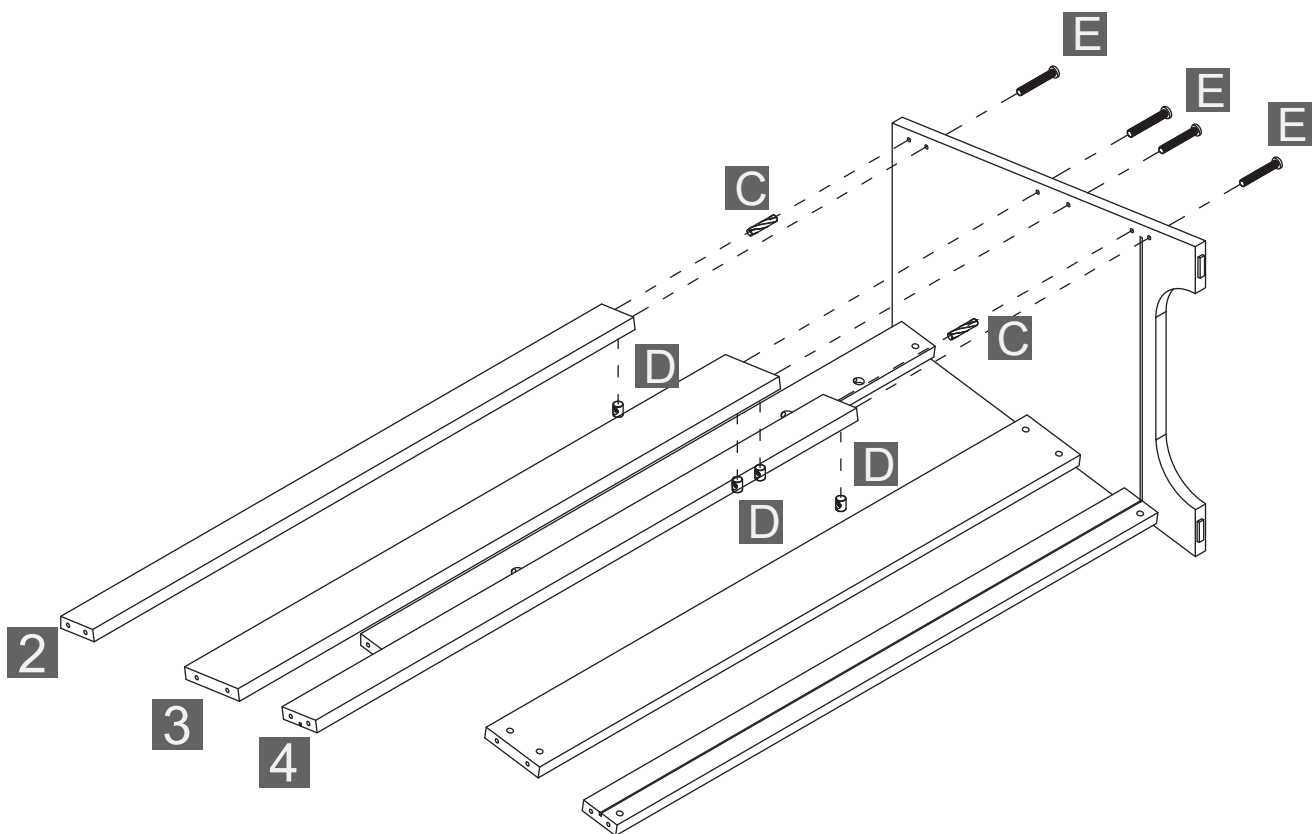

Insert two wood dowels **C** into support bar **2**, cross bar **3** and cross bar **4**. Align and insert the wood dowels into the holes on right side panel **7** as shown. Insert four barrel nuts **D** into the holes of support bar **2**, upper cross bar **3** and lower cross bar **4**. Affix support bar **2**, upper cross bar **3** and lower cross bar **4** to right side panel **7** using four bolts **E**. Tighten using hex key **F**.

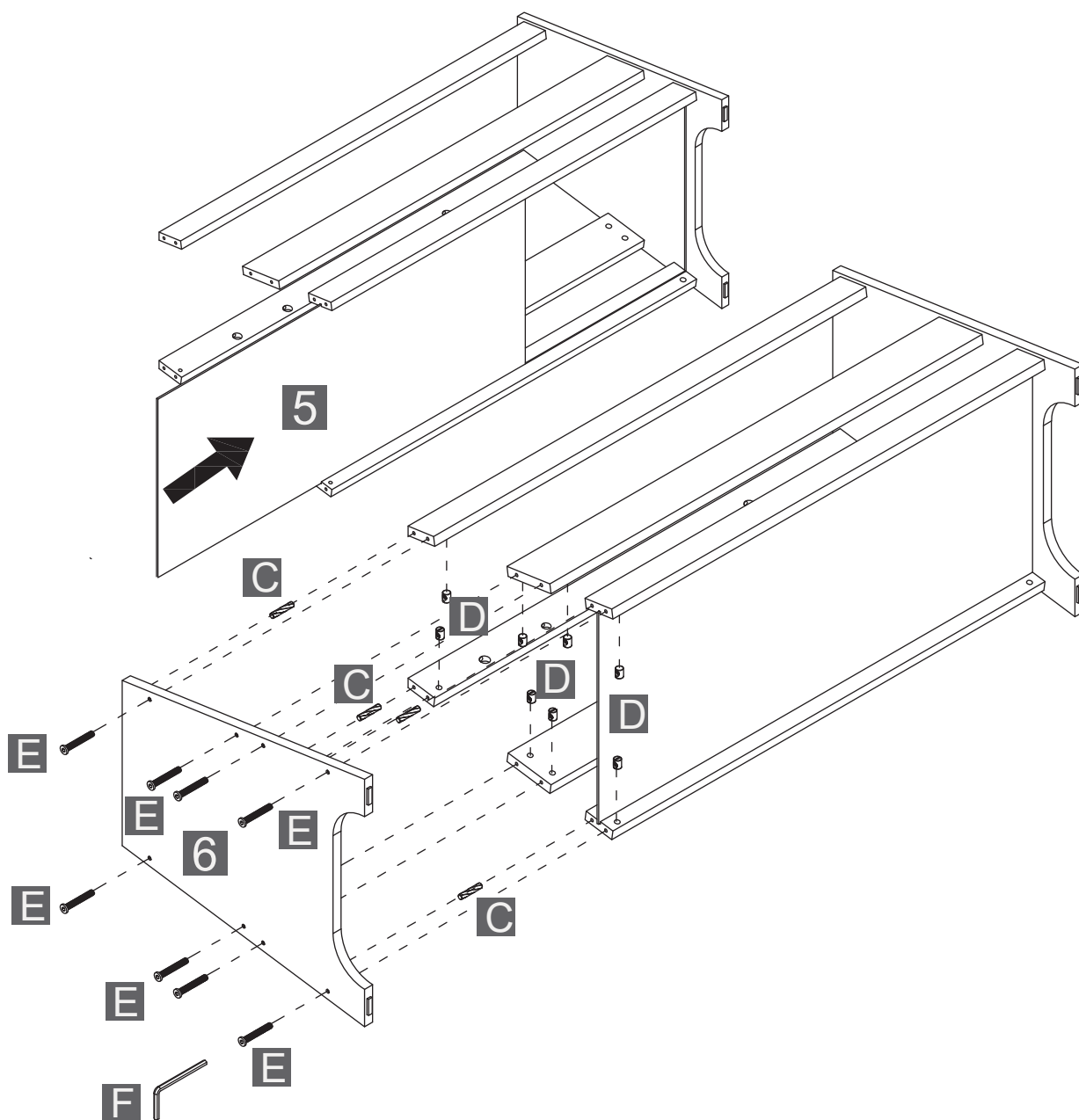
Insert shelf **5** into the groove between two lower cross bars **4**.

Insert four wood dowels **C** into support bar **2**, upper cross bar **3** and lower cross bar **4**.

Align and insert the wood dowels into the holes on left side panel **6** as shown.





Insert eight barrel nuts **D** into the holes of support bar **2**, upper cross bar **3** and lower cross bar **4**.

Affix support bars **2**, upper cross bars **3** and lower cross bars **4** to left side panel **6** using eight bolts **E**. Tighten using hex key **F**.

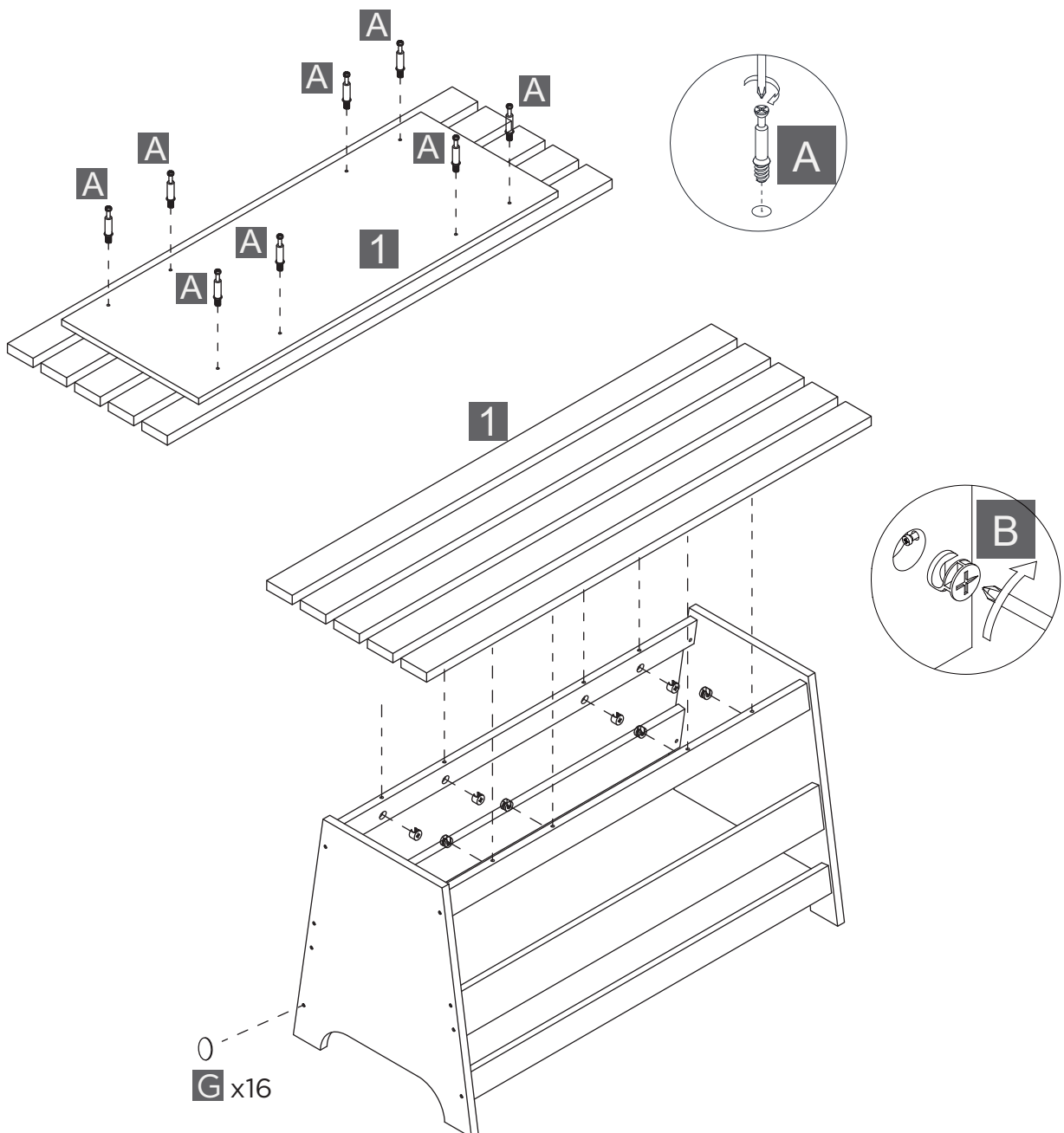

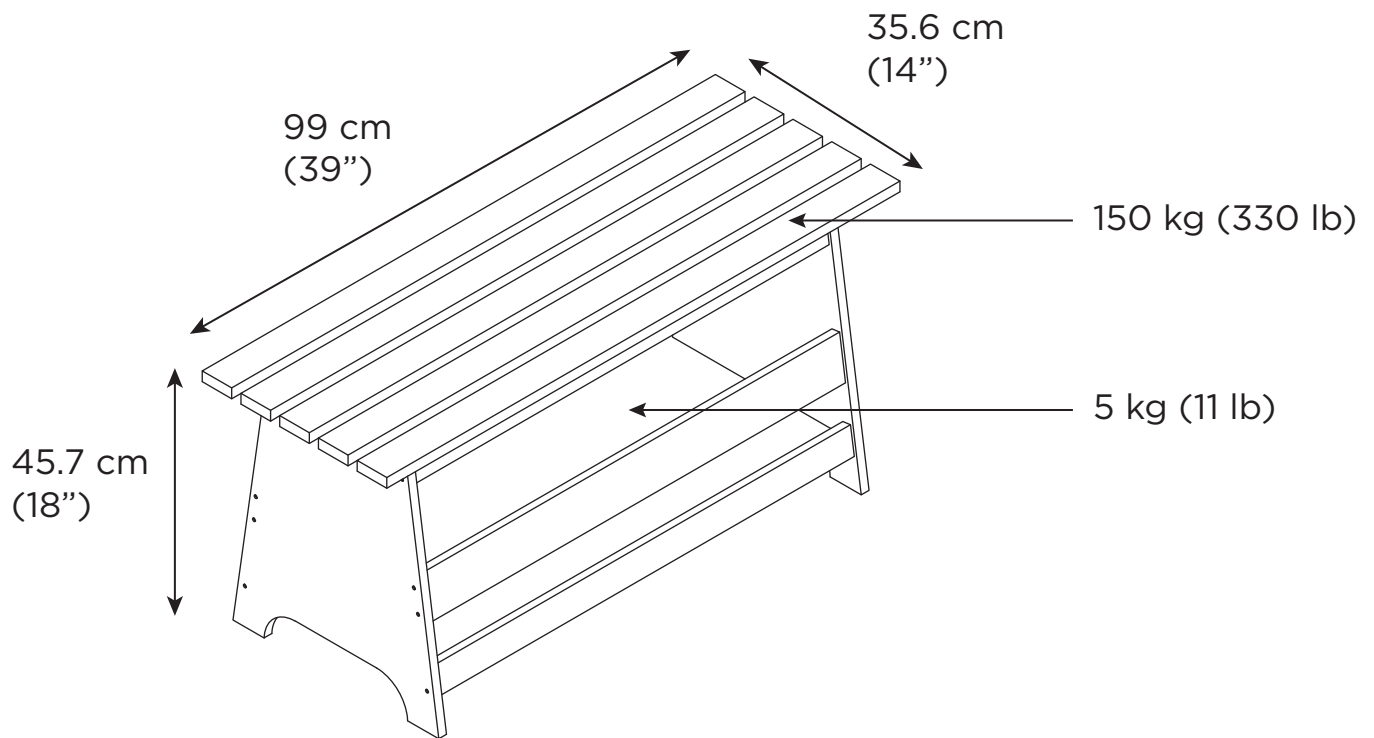
### STEP 4

<b>1</b> x1	<b>A</b> x8	<b>B</b> x8	<b>G</b> x16
			

Insert eight cam bolts **A** into the back of the top panel **1**.  
Flip over the top panel **1**, insert the cam bolts into the top of support bar **2**.  
Insert eight cam locks **B** into the side of support bar **2**.  
Tighten all cam locks.  
Cover all visible hardware holes using twelve coated paper stickers **G**.
