- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if the protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.

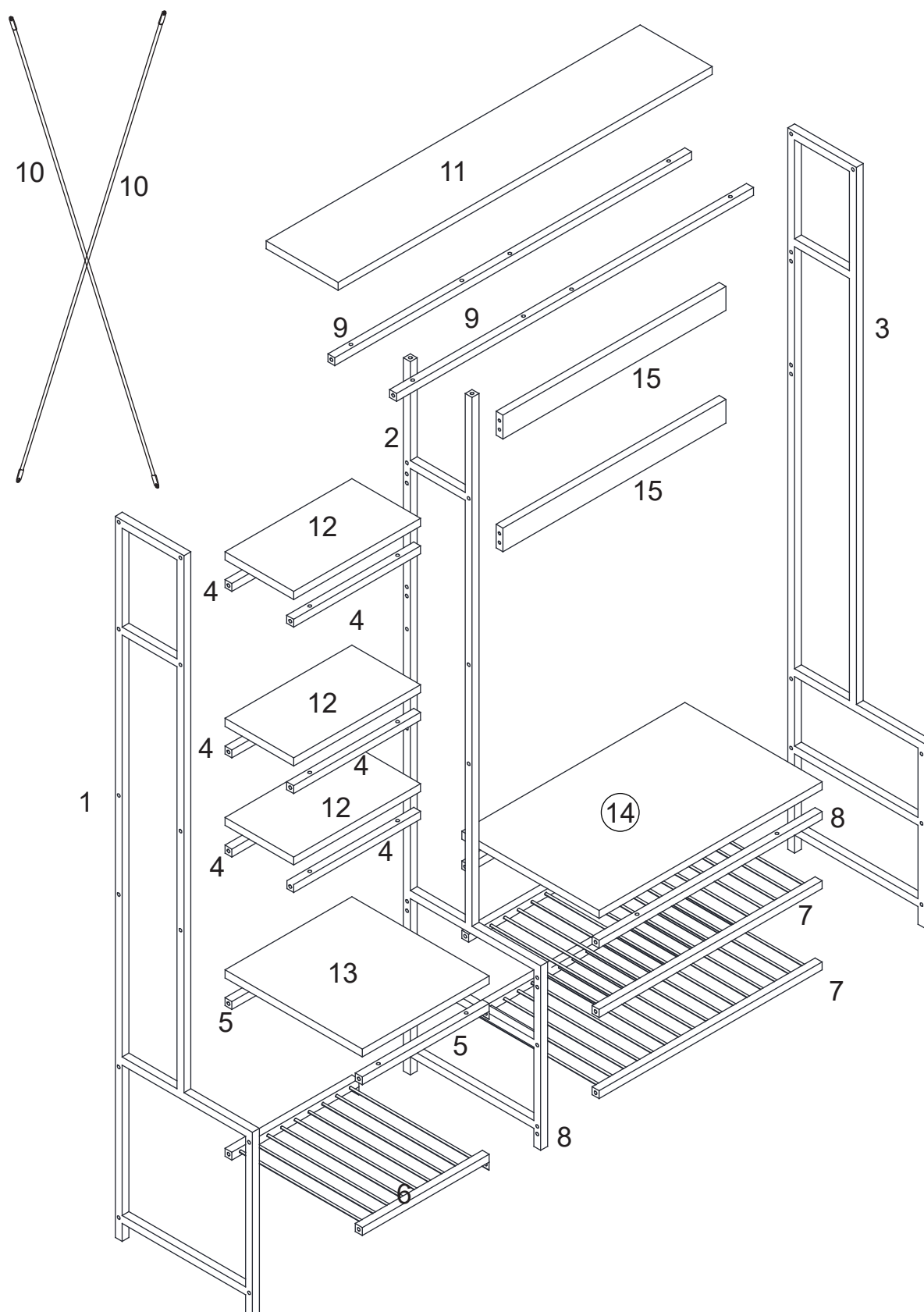
No. 2 Cross-head Screwdriver

BEFORE YOU BEGIN ASSEMBLY

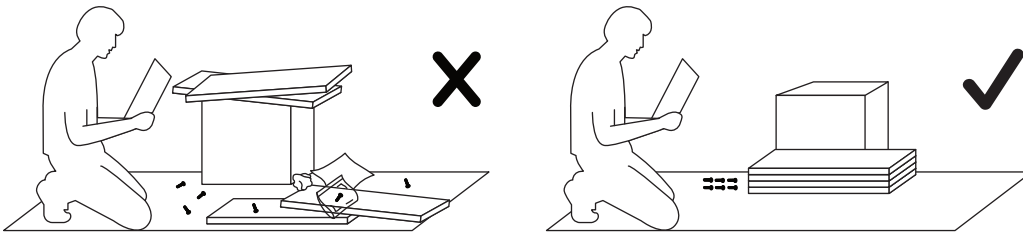
MAKE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT

Compare all pieces to the parts and hardware lists, and make sure you have all tools required for assembly.



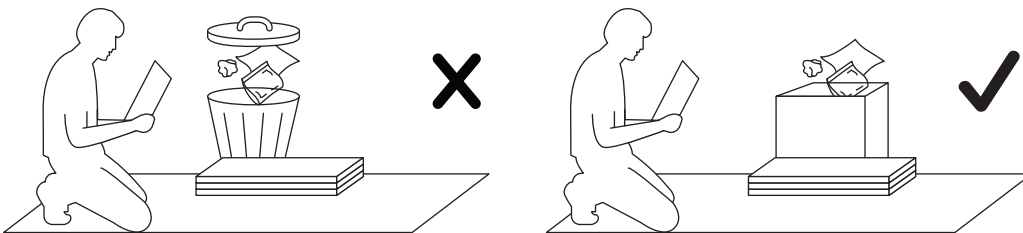
ASSEMBLE IN A CLEARED AREA

Place all parts from the box on the floor in front of you on a clean, dry, level surface to protect the product as it is being built.



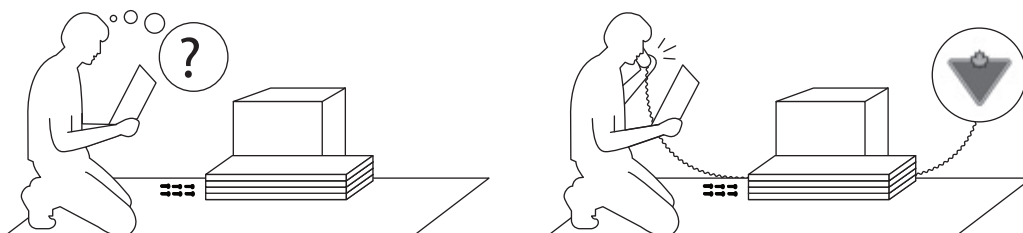
REMOVE PACKAGING MATERIALS

Place packing materials back in the box. Do not dispose of packaging materials until assembly is complete.





Insert four bolts M6x30 **B** through two support bars **4** into shelf **12**.
Tighten all bolts with hex key **D**.
Repeat this step 2 more times.

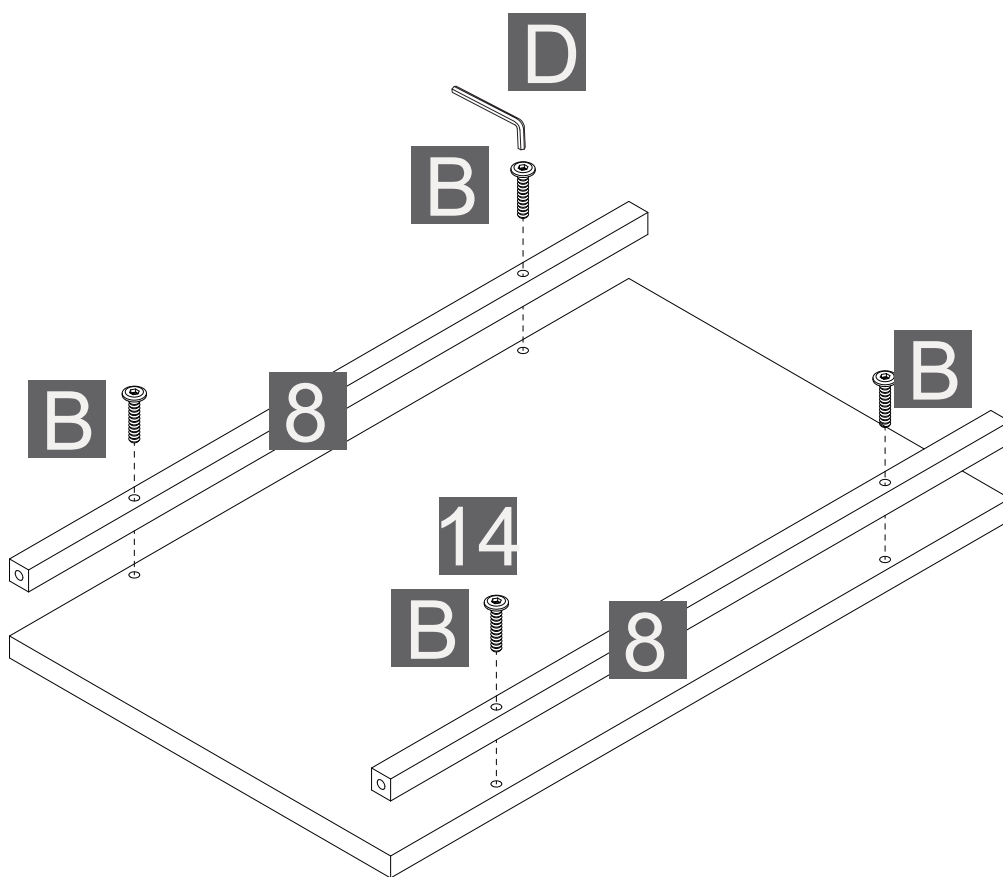

STEP 2



Insert four bolts M6x30 **B** through two seat plate support bars **8** into seat plate **14**. Tighten all bolts with hex key **D**.

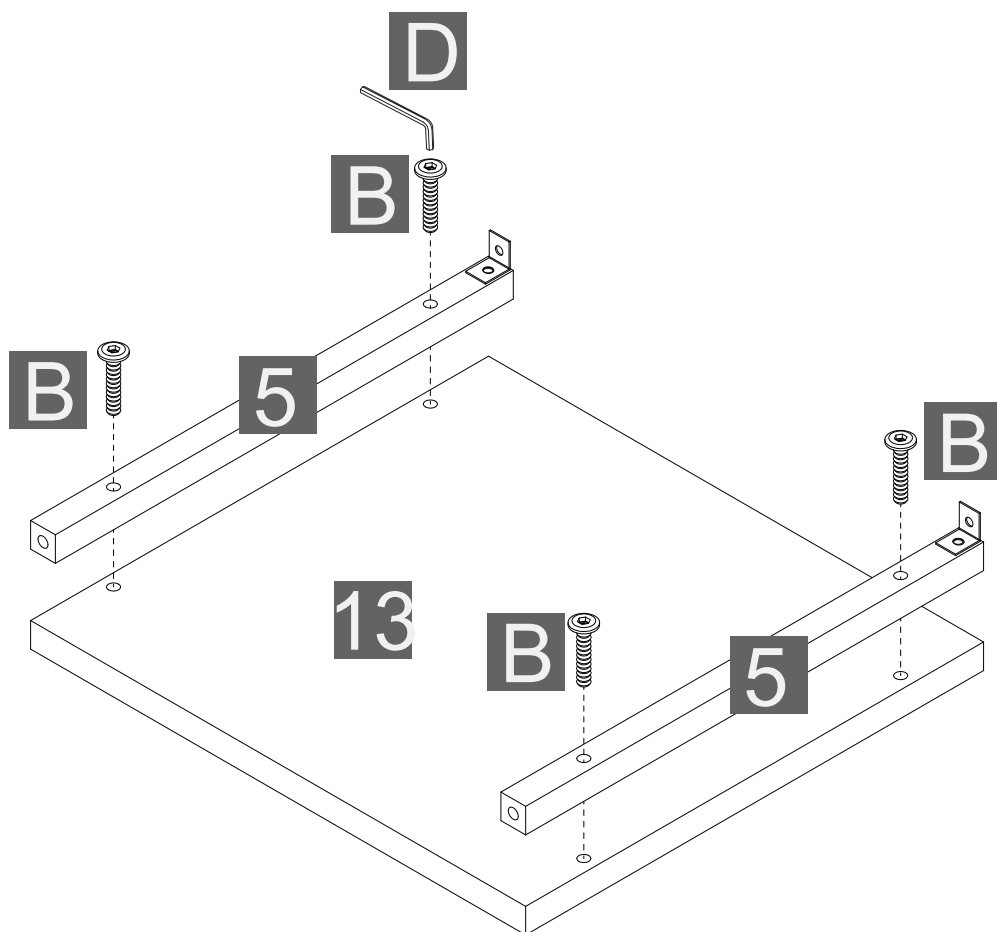

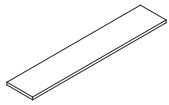
Insert four bolts M6x30 **B** through two support bars **5** into shelf **13**. Tighten all bolts with hex key **D**.












Insert two screws **I** through anti-tip brackets **H** into top panel **11**.
Tighten all screws.

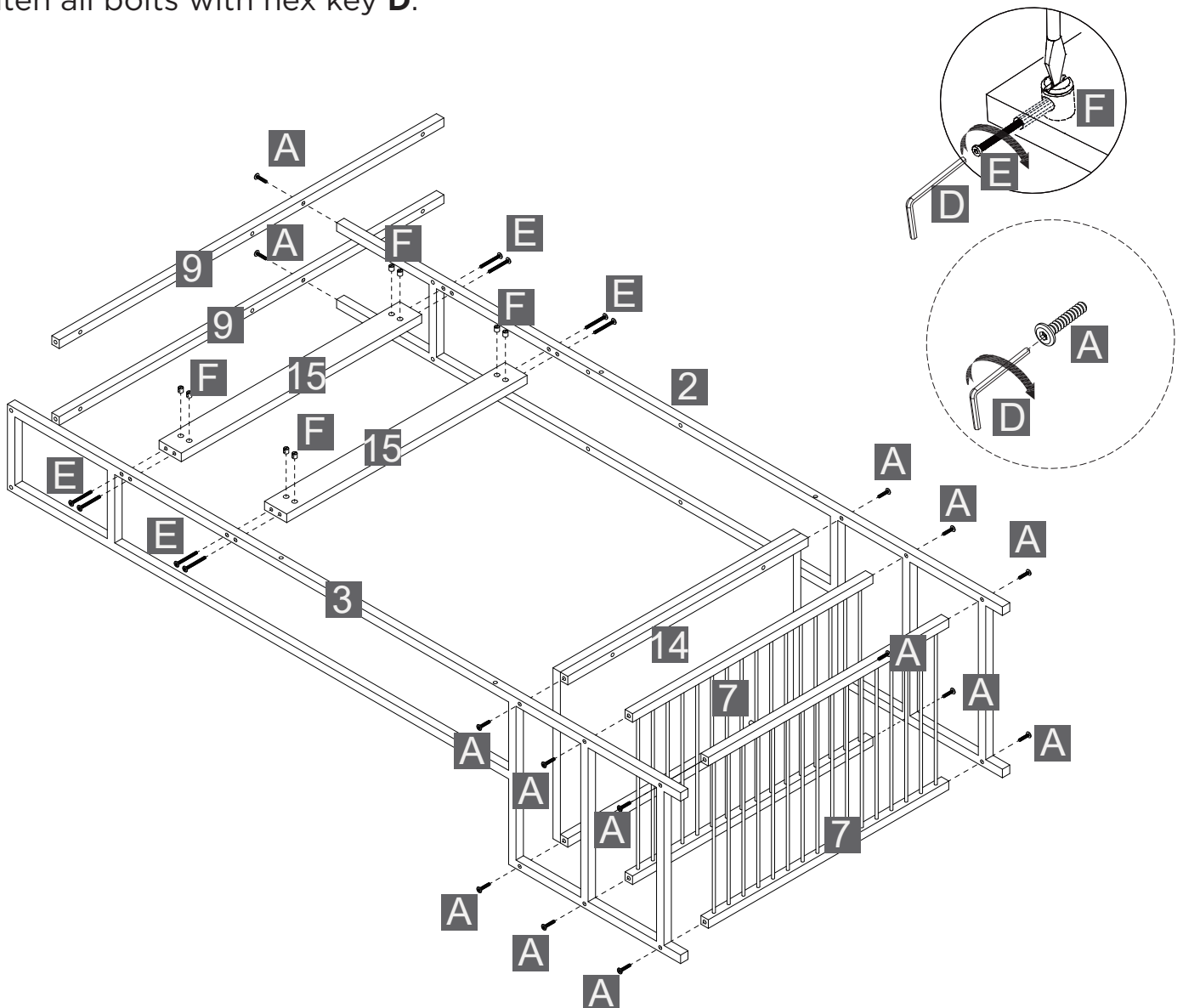
Insert eight barrel nuts **F** into hanging racks **15**.

Insert eight bolts M6x50 **E** through middle frame **2** and right side frame **3** into hanging racks **15**.

Insert twelve bolts M6x40 **A** through middle frame **2** and right side frame **3** into seat plate support bar **8** and wide metal shelves **7**.






Insert two bolts M6x40 **A** through support bars **9** into middle frame **2**.

Tighten all bolts with hex key **D**.

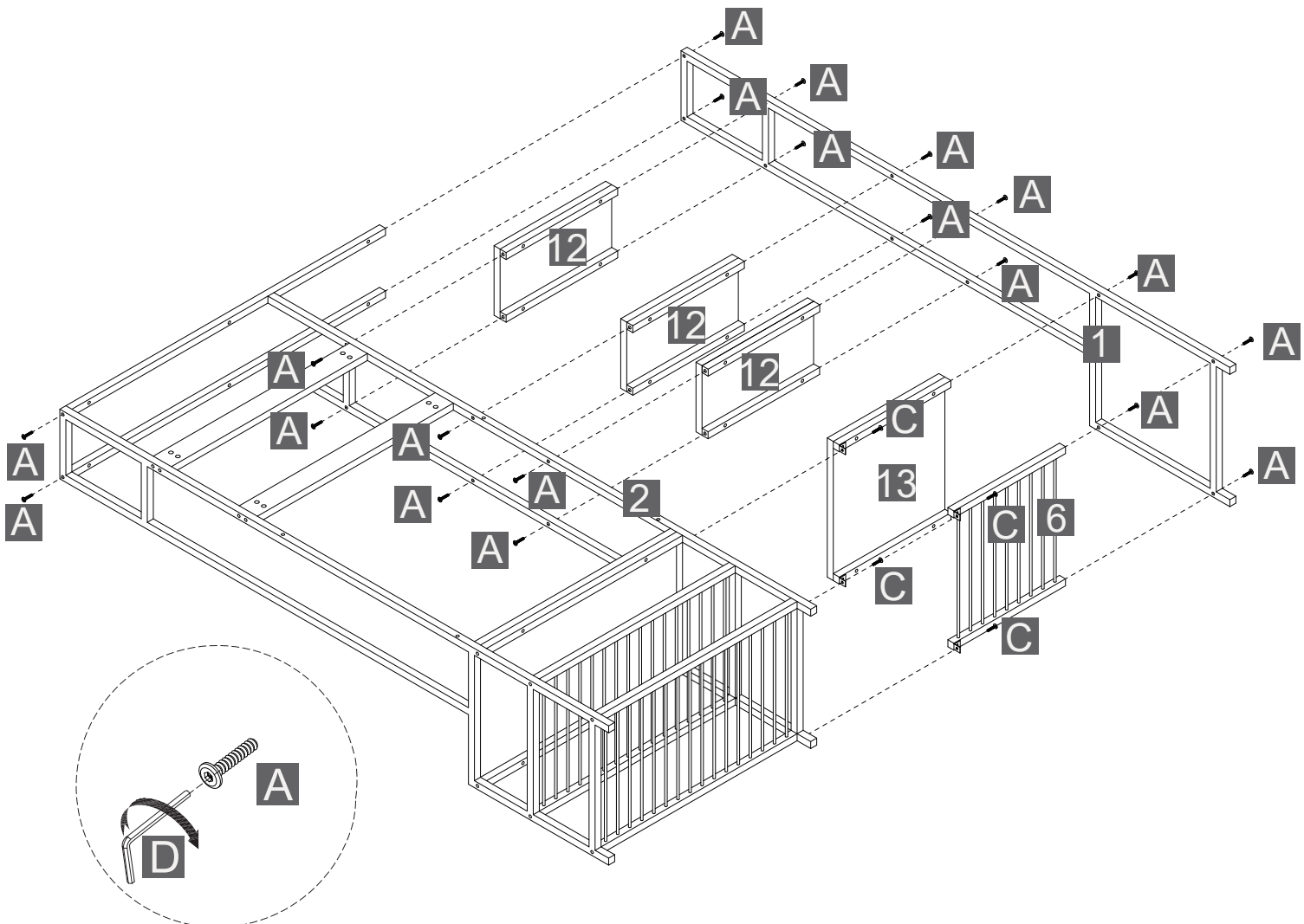



Insert two bolts M6x40 **A** through right side frame **3** into support bars **9**.
 Insert six bolts M6x40 **A** through middle frame **2** into shelf support bars **4**.
 Insert twelve bolts M6x40 **A** through left side frame **1** into support bar **9**, shelf support bars **4**, support bar **5** and metal shelf **6**.
 Insert four bolts M6x10 **C** through shelf **13** and metal shelf **6** into middle frame **2**.
 Tighten all bolts with hex key **D**.

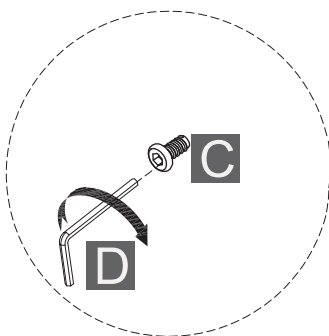
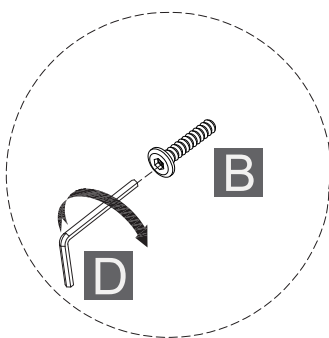
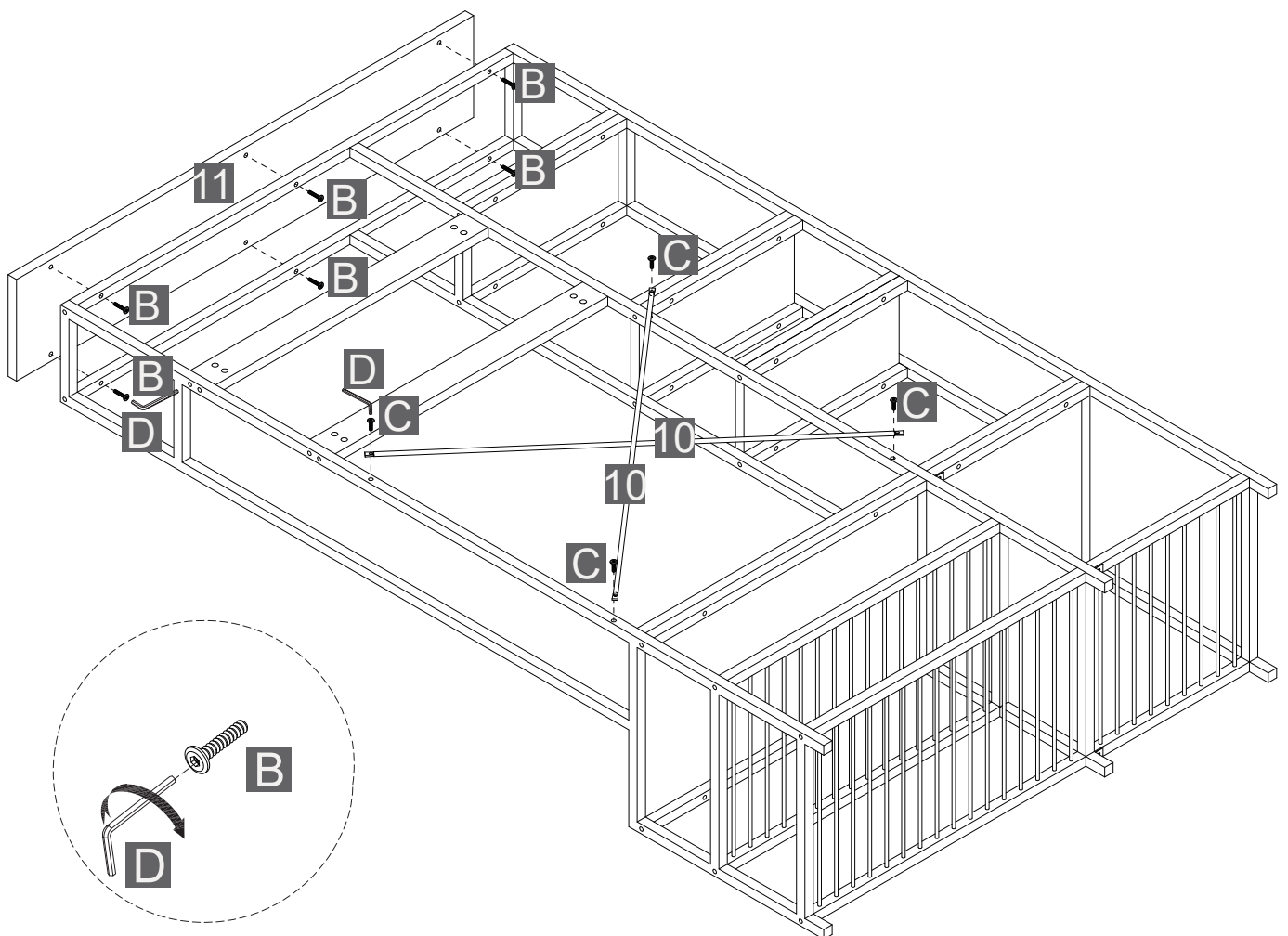

Insert six bolts M6x30 **B** through support bars **9** into top panel **11**.
Insert four bolts **C** through back cross bars **10** into right side frame **3** and middle frame **2**.
Tighten all bolts with hex key **D**.



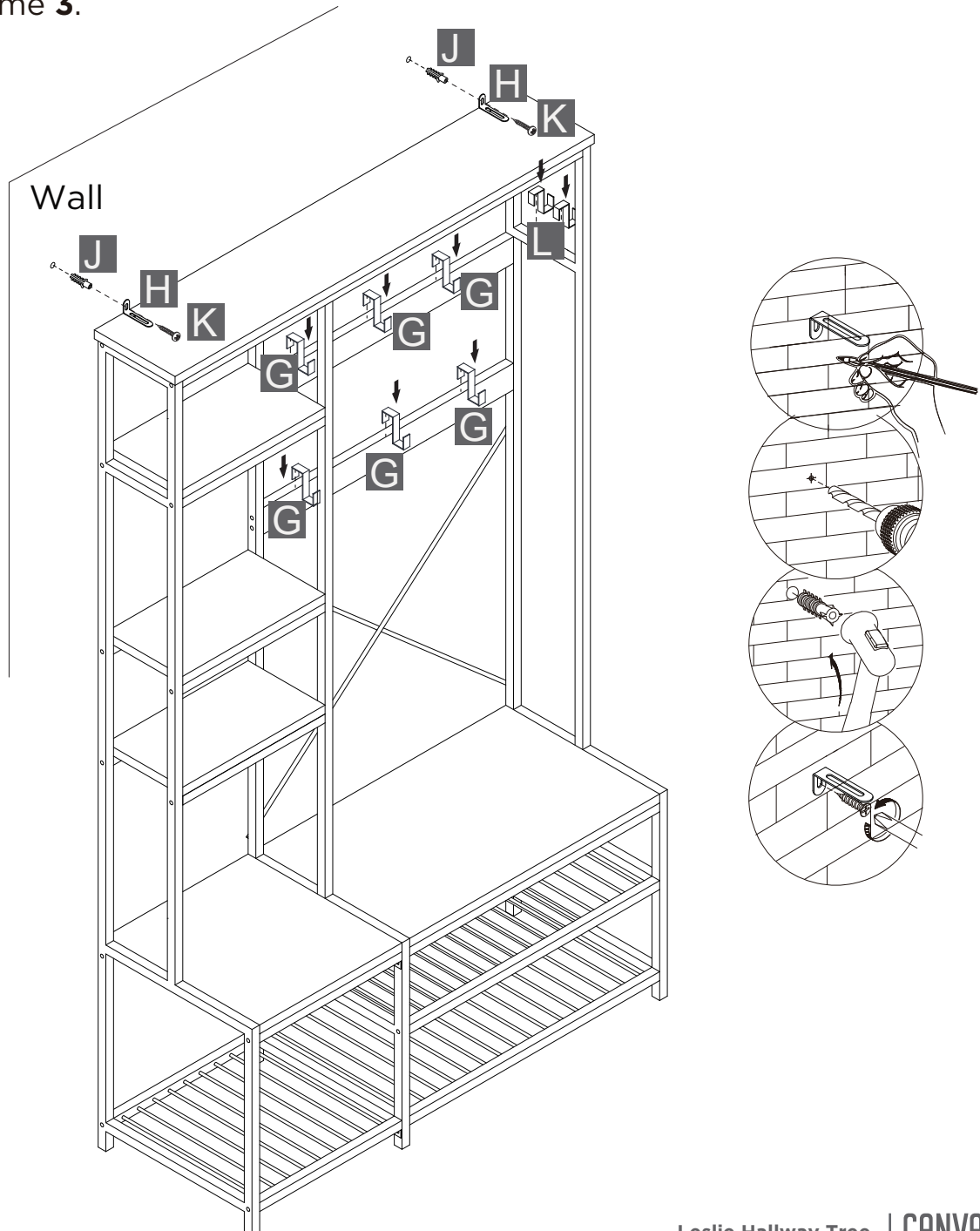

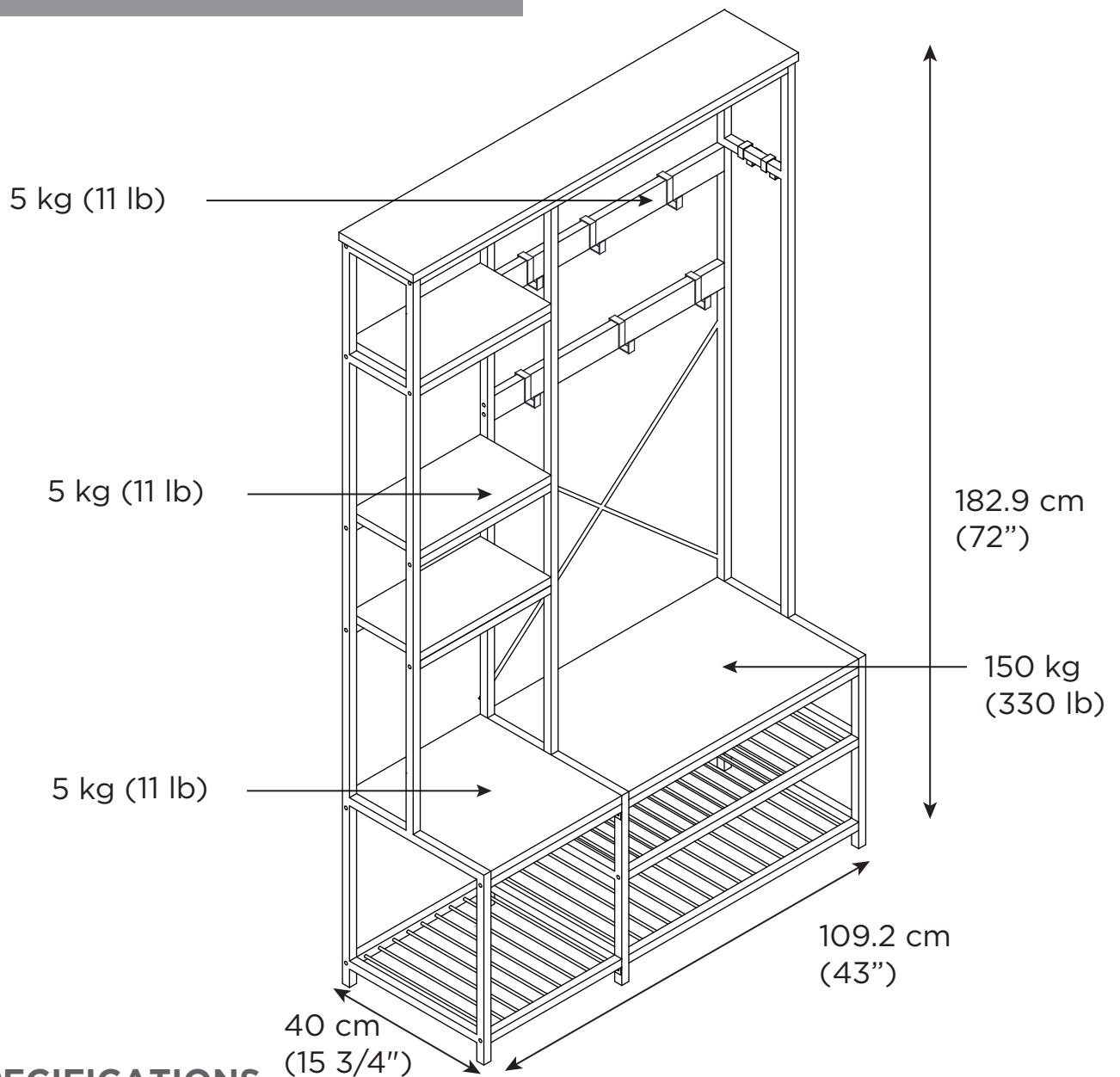

Using the anti-tip brackets as a guide, mark two spots on the wall. Drill a hole at each mark on the wall stud, hammer two wall anchors **J** into the wall, and fasten the anti-tip brackets using two screws **M4x35 K** screwed into the wall anchors **J**. Tighten all screws.

Hang six hanging rack hooks **G** and two side hooks **L** on the hanging racks **15** and right side frame **3**.
