






Warning! Please use your furniture correctly and safely. Improper use can cause safety hazards, or damage to your furniture or household items. Carefully read the following safety information.

- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if the protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.



No. 2 Cross-head Screwdriver Tip Shown Actual Size







Before You Begin Assembly



Make Sure All Parts Are Present

Compare all pieces to the parts and hardware lists, and make sure you have all tools required for assembly.



Assemble in a Cleared Area

Place all parts from the box on the floor in front of you on a clean, dry, level surface to protect the product as it is being built.




Remove Packaging Materials

Place packing materials back in the box. Do not dispose of packaging materials until assembly is complete.






Step 1




Insert eight cam bolts **(A)** into left panel **(2)**. Insert one screw M4x12 **(H)** through anti-tip bracket **(G)** into left panel **(2)**. Insert four screws M3x14 **(F)** through two left slide rails **(D)** into left panel **(2)**. Tighten all cam bolts and screws.




Step 2



Insert eight cam bolts **(A)** into right panel **(4)**. Insert one screw M4x12 **(H)** through anti-tip bracket **(G)** into right panel **(4)**. Insert four screws M3x14 **(F)** through two right slide rails **(E)** into right panel **(4)**. Tighten all cam bolts and screws.






Insert four cam bolts (A) into two partitions (3) as shown.

Insert eight screws M3x14 (F) through four left slide rails (D) into the right side of partitions (3).


Insert eight screws M3x14 (F) through four right slide rails (E) into the left side of partitions (3).




Step 4




Insert four wood dowels 6x50 **(L)** into the partitions **(3)**. Attach two back slats **(6)** to partitions **(3)**. Insert four cam locks **(B)** into back slats **(6)**. Tighten all cam locks.




Step 5




Insert two cam bolts **(A)** and four wood dowels **(C)** into bottom panel **(7)**. Attach two bottom aprons **(10)** to the bottom panel **(7)**. Insert two cam locks **(B)** into the bottom aprons **(10)**. Tighten all cam locks.




Step 6




Insert four wood dowels **(C)** into the partitions **(3)**. Attach bottom panel **(7)** to the partitions **(3)**. Insert four screws **(M)** through bottom panel **(7)** into partition **(3)**. Tighten all screws.




Step 7



Attach two back slats **(6)** to the partitions **(3)**. Insert four cam locks **(B)** into back slats **(6)**. Tighten all cam locks.




Step 8




Insert eight wood dowels (C) into the upper aprons (5), back slats (6), bottom panel (7) and bottom aprons (10).

Attach right panel (4) to the upper aprons (5), back slats (6), bottom panel (7) and bottom aprons (10).


Insert eight cam locks (B) into the upper aprons (5), back slats (6), bottom panel (7) and bottom aprons (10).




Step 9



Insert two wood dowels **(C)** into the left panel **(2)**. Attach two back slats **(6)** to left panel **(2)**. Insert two cam locks **(B)** into the back slats **(6)**. Tighten all cam locks.



Step 10




Insert six wood dowels **(C)** into the upper aprons **(5)**, back slats **(6)**, bottom panel **(7)** and bottom aprons **(10)**.


Attach left panel (2) to the upper aprons (5), back slats (6), bottom panel (7) and bottom aprons (10).

Insert eight cam locks (B) into the upper aprons (5), back slats (6), bottom panel (7) and bottom aprons (10).


Tighten all cam locks.




Step 11



Insert ten cam bolts **(A)** into the top panel **(1)**. Tighten all cam bolts.




Step 12




Insert twelve wood dowels **(C)** into the left panel **(2)**, right panel **(4)** and upper aprons **(5)**. Attach top panel **(1)** to the left panel **(2)**, right panel **(4)** and upper aprons **(5)**. Insert ten cam locks **(B)** to the left panel **(2)**, right panel **(4)** and upper aprons **(5)**. Tighten all cam locks.

Add eight coated paper stickers **(K)** to the screw holes on the left panel **(2)**, right panel **(4)** and upper aprons **(5)**.




Step 13




Using the anti-tip brackets as a guide, mark two spots on the wall. Drill a hole at each mark on the wall, hammer two wall anchors (**J**) into the wall, and fasten the anti-tip brackets using two screws M4x35 (**I**) screwed into the wall anchors (**J**).




Step 14



Insert three small bins (9) and three large bins (8) to the groove of the slide rails, which are on the left panel, partitions and right panel.
