

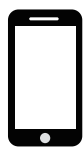

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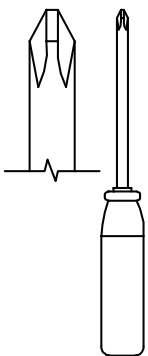

- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if this protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.

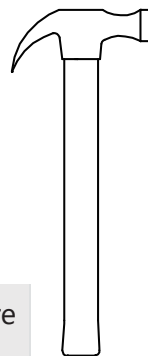

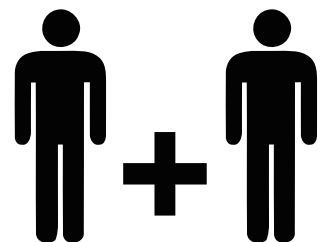
No. 2 Cross-head Screwdriver

NOTE: A drill is not recommended. Be aware of over-drilling in order to avoid damage





EXPLODED VIEW



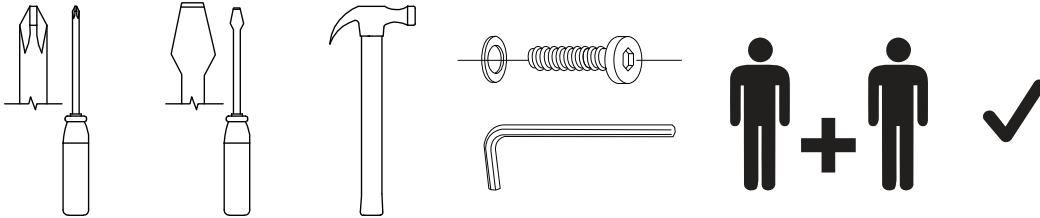

BEFORE YOU BEGIN ASSEMBLY

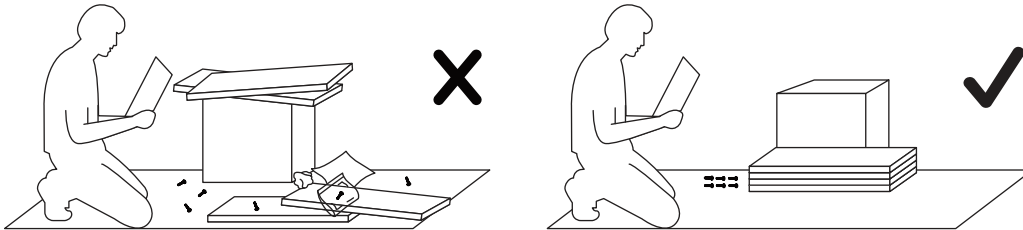
MAKE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT

Compare all pieces to the parts and hardware lists, and make sure you have all tools required for assembly.



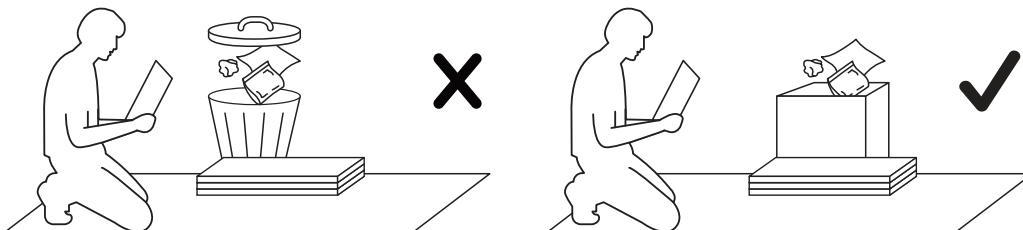
ASSEMBLE IN A CLEARED AREA

Place all parts from the box on the floor in front of you on a clean, dry, level surface to protect the product as it is being built.



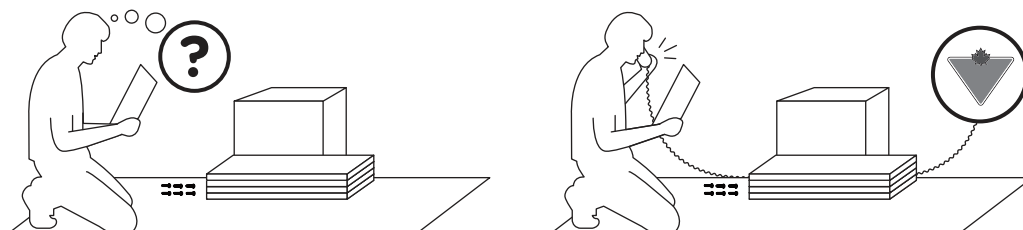
REMOVE PACKAGING MATERIALS

Place packing materials back in the box. Do not dispose of packaging materials until assembly is complete.



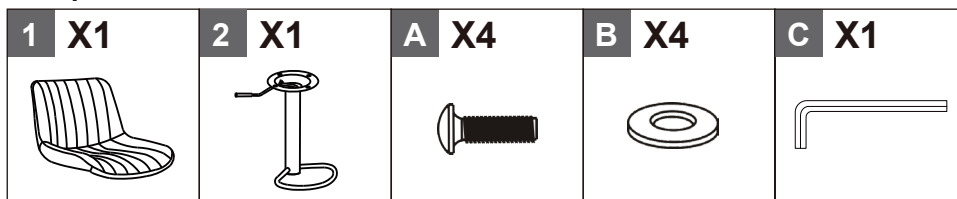

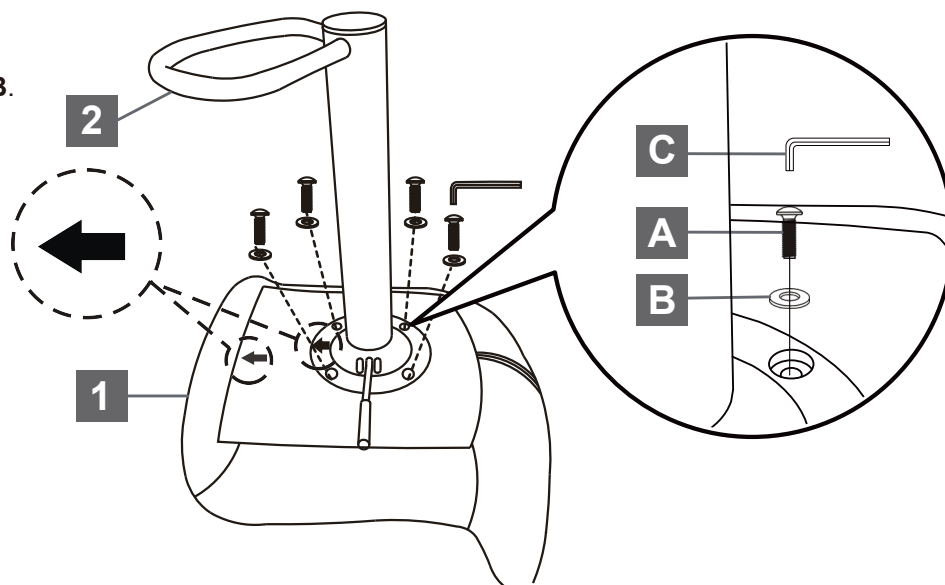


STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

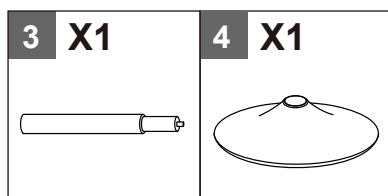
Step 1



Attach the seat plate **2** to the bottom of seat **1** using the bolts **A** with washers **B**. When assembled, tighten the screws with the hex key **C**.

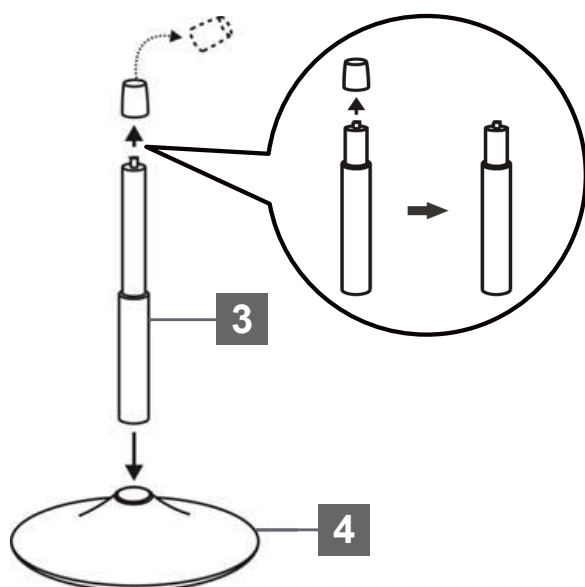


Step 2



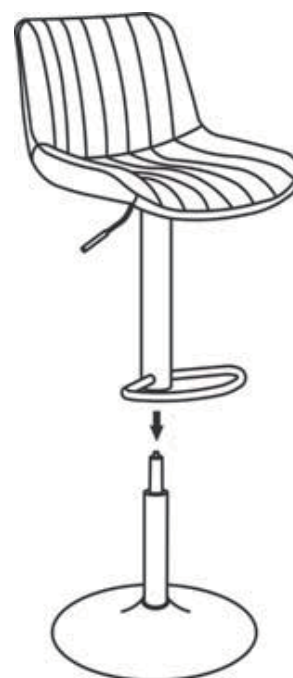
IMPORTANT: REMOVE CAP!

Connect gaslift **3** to base **4**.

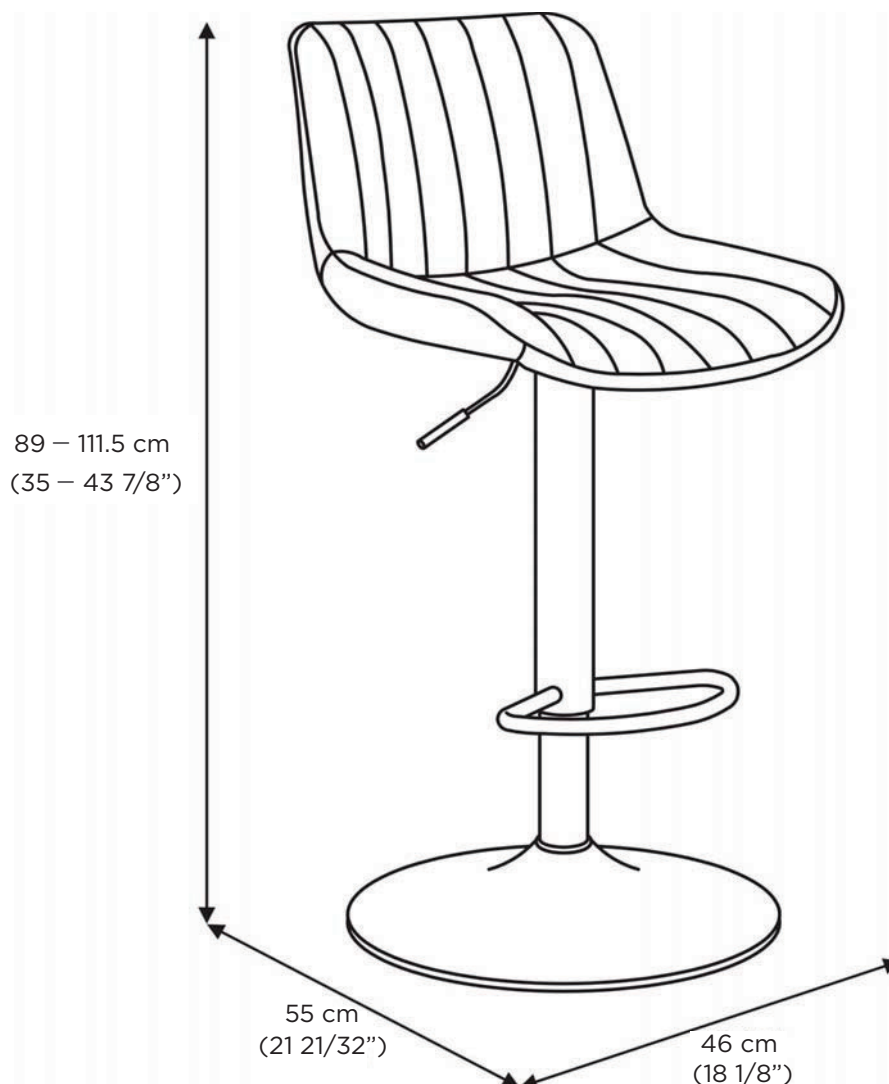


Step 3

PRODUCT TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSES	SOLUTION
The base wobbles or is unstable after installation.	The base is not properly installed or matched, or the ground is uneven causing the base to be unable to have full contact with the floor.	Ensure that the gaslift and the base are connected securely, and check the flatness of the contact surface between the base and the ground.
The gaslift fails to lift smoothly, or there are issues such as stuckness or abnormal noise during lifting.	The gaslift is not installed correctly, or there are impurities or damage inside the gaslift.	Re-install the gaslift correctly and ensure it is securely fixed. If necessary, ask for gaslift replacement.

CARING FOR YOUR ITEM

- 1 To clean the seat, use water or mild detergent. If there is solvent on the stool, clean with dry cloth and water.
- 2 Product should be placed horizontally on flat ground.
- 3 Screws and joints should be re-tightened regularly.
- 4 Do not sit on the front edge of the product.
- 5 Please store the product in a dry and clean area.
