





IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION!



- Proper placement of your gazebo is essential.
 Do not place the product underneath electrical lines.
- Keep children away during assembly. This product contains small parts which can be swallowed by children.
- Keep fingers away from places where they can be pinched or trapped.
- Do not attempt to assemble the gazebo if any parts are missing.
- Wood is NOT flame-resistant and will burn.
 Grills, fire pits and chimneys are a fire hazard if placed too close to wooden structures. Consult user's manual of the grill, fire pit or chimney for safe distances from any flammable materials.

IMPORTANT: Wood components are manufactured with cedar wood which is coated with a water-based stain. Knots and small checks (cracks) are naturally occurring and do not affect the strength of the product. It is advisable to annually maintain the wooden parts of the gazebo with a coat of water-based water repellent sealant or outdoor wax or oil to protect & enhance the beauty of the wood.

- This product is intended for outdoor use only.
- The product should be assembled on a flat stable surface.
- Do not assemble the gazebo on unstable surfaces.
- Ensure the location and clearance of your gazebo is acceptable.

 The gazebo must be anchored with stakes into the ground for added safety. It is recommended that it should not be permanently attached to a concrete floor or platform.
- This gazebo is not to be regarded as part of a building/house structure. The gazebo is to be anchored onto the ground for added safety. Do not assemble the gazebo onto soil/earth ground. It is best to have the gazebo built onto a wooden deck or concrete base for stability. If it is to be built onto a wooden deck over the ground, do ensure that the deck over the ground has a strong foundation. It is advisable to use appropriate floor plugs (not provided) to anchor the gazebo onto the wooden deck or concrete base.
- Some structures may require two or more people to install safely. Check for underground utilities before digging or driving stakes into the ground.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- During installation, follow all safety warnings provided with your tools, and use safety glasses.
- In case you set up more than one gazebo, keep a minimum distance of 3 m (10') between the gazebos.
- Arrange the necessary manpower when assembling or moving the product.
- Some parts may contain sharp edges. Wear protective gloves and glasses if necessary.
- Keep children and pets away while setting up the gazebo.
- Check all nuts and bolts periodically for tightness. When required, tighten them again.
- Repairing and replacing parts should be done by a qualified technician.
- The gazebo is intended for decorative and shade purposes only, and is not designed to withstand harsh weather, including high winds, rain and snow.
- If the product is not being used for long periods of time (e.g., winter), it should be stored in a clean, dry environment.
- Do not put a liquid-propane or wood-burning firepit or fireplace inside the product.
- Do not climb or place heavy objects onto the gazebo roof.
- Retain the original packaging to store and protect the gazebo during the winter months.
- •Do not use or enter the gazebo if any of the following conditions exist:
- -Visible movement of supports, roofing panels or a sagging roof;
- -Unusual noise from the gazebo:
- -Deformed roof panels:
- -Damaged or missing bolts/fasteners.
- •Please check your HOA and local government agencies prior to purchasing and assembling gazebos. These local organizations may require permits and may have specific requirements for installation.
- Maintain your instruction manual for future reference.
- Warranty: Please retain you receipt for proof of purchase.


Note: Posts from the ground must be upright in order to install the last two crossbeams.











Do note that all 4 horizontal beams are to be horizontal and aligned (please see Fig 1, which shows wrong alignment). At the 4 corners of the horizontal beams, the beam when installed has a small gap to allow for expansion of the wood.

While installing the horizontal beams & ensuring the consistency of the gap at all four corners, it may be necessary to loosen the bolts and make the adjustment to achieve a consistent gap at all 4 corners before tightening the bolts again.


Important notes:

- 1) Adjustment must be made prior to the installation of the roof.
- 2) Do not over-torque the mounting bolts. Over-torqueing the bolts will crush the cedar wood.



CARING FOR YOUR ITEM



CAUTION! CHECK ALL SCREWS AND NUTS PERIODICALLY FOR TIGHTNESS, FASTENING THEM AGAIN AS REQUIRED.

Always keep children under close supervision while they are using or around this product. Never leave children unattended.

This product is intended for outdoor use only.

Do not light any fires below or near the product.

Clean the gazebo with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and wait until the product is dry before reassembling it.

Check all nuts and bolts periodically for tightness. When required, tighten them again.

Disassemble the gazebo in the reverse order of the assembly steps. Always disassemble the gazebo completely. A partially disassembled gazebo is not stable enough to resist wind and bad weather, and therefore can be damaged and/or cause damage.

Remove all excess snow from the roof.

Cleaning & **Use & Care** Instructions

Do not shake, lean or climb on gazebo.

Clean and dry before storing in a dry, sheltered area. Do not use bleach, acid, or other abrasive cleaners on the canopies or frame parts.

Steel components for this gazebo are treated with rust inhibiting paint to prevent and limit rusting. However, due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if these protective coatings are scratched. This is not a defect and thus not covered by the warranty. To minimize this condition, it is recommended to use care when assembling and handling the product to prevent scratching of the paint. Should any scratching or damage occur, it is recommended to cover the scratch immediately with rust inhibiting paint (not included). Surface rust can also be easily removed with a very light application of regular cooking oil. If surface oxidation (rusting) occurs and if no measure is taken to prevent this, the oxidation may start dripping onto deck or patio and cause damaging stains, which may be difficult to remove. This can be prevented if the above-mentioned measures are taken to keep the product from oxidizing.

In the maintenance of the wooden posts or beams of the gazebo, use wood sandpaper of grit 180 to sand the wood surface to remove any foreign stains or dirt. Wipe off the sanding powder and any dirt with a clean dry cloth before applying a coat of protective varnish/wax.

Carefully read the instructions of the varnish/wax oil before application. It is best to try on a small section of wood, check the result and if satisfied with the result, then apply the varnish/wax oil onto the remaining wooden parts.

Keep instruction manual for future reference.

Keep the original packaging to store the gazebo.

DO NOT mix old and new batteries, different brands or types of batteries, such as alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

IF THE LIGHT DOES NOT WORK:

- 1) Check to ensure there are no obstructions over the top of the solar panel.
- 2) Check that the battery is installed correctly and ensure nothing is preventing the battery terminals from making contact.
- 3) Check to ensure the solar panel is positioned to sense both daylight and nighttime. If bright light shines near or into the solar panel, these lights may trigger the sensor and the lights may turn off, Bright lights can act like daylight and prevent the unit from functioning correctly.
- 4) Batteries may need to be changed as they vary by use, temperature, weather conditions and heat. Replace the batteries with the same type of rechargeable batteries.
- 5) Ensure the batteries are fully charged. It is important to charge the battery for 12 hours in full sun before use. Cloudy or rainy days may require a longer charging time.
- 6) In some cases, you may need to open the battery compartment and "seat" the battery correctly between metal clips as some dislodging may occur during shipment, and to ensure the correct polarity position.
