


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: Please read this manual carefully before attempting to assemble, operate or install the product, and save it for reference.

The following rules must be adhered to when assembling the product. If you have any doubts about how to install the product or if it fails to work properly, contact a local, licensed electrician. Failure to comply with these requirements could lead to an electric shock or fire, which could cause serious injury or fatality.

- Power at the main fuse box is disconnected before installing the fixture.
- The fixture ground wire (bare or green insulated wire) is NOT connected to current-carrying
- No bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors when joining current-carrying
- The insulation on wires has not been damaged during installation.
- No rough or sharp edges are in contact with any of the wires.
- Fixture wires are connected to the proper house supply wires. If you have any doubts about which house supply wire is white and which is black, contact a licensed electrician.
- Light bulbs with wattage no greater than those specified for the fixture are used.
- Power is off when installing light bulbs into the fixture.

Before beginning assembly of this product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and hardware contents list. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product.

Place all parts from the box in a cleared area and position them on the floor in front of you. Remove all packing materials and place them back into the box. Do not dispose of the packing materials until assembly is complete. Read each step carefully before beginning any assembly and make sure you understand each step.

Tools required for assembly (not included):

Flat-head screwdriver, cross-head screwdriver, electrical tape, safety glasses, ladder, wire strippers, pliers.











. Remove the preassembled cap nuts (EE) from the mounting screws (BB). Save for late use. Separate the crossbar (AA) from the canopy (G).



2. Attach the crossbar (AA) to outlet box (not included) using the outlet box screws (CC).


Note: Mounting screws (BB) should protrude out from the outlet box.



B. Feed the wires from the fixture body (A) through the bottom rod (D), middle rod (E) and top rod (F). Pull cord taut, then attach rod assembly together. Secure the bottom rod (D) to the top of the fixture body (A).

Note: To ensure proper assembly, make sure to route the wires through the ends of the rods with the threaded nipple first.

Weave the wires through canopy (A). Then, screw the canopy (G) into the top rod (F).



4. Strip 3/4" (19 mm) of insulation from fixture wire ends. Twist stripped ends together with pliers (not included). Connect the white, ribbed or tinned wire without writing from the fixture with the white wire from the outlet box. Connect the black, smooth, or un-tinned wire with writing from the fixture to the black wire from the outlet box in same manner. Snip ends. Wrap the ground wire from the outlet box around the green screw preassembled on the crossbar (AA), and then connect the ground wire from the outlet box to the ground wire from the

Attach wire nuts (DD) to ends. Tape wire nuts (DD) and wires together with electrical tape (not included).


5. Place canopy (A) over the mounting screws (BB), 5 securing with previously removed cap nuts (EE).

6. Remove socket rings (C) from fixture body (A). Then place the glass shades (B) over the sockets, securing with socket rings (C).

7. Install the bulbs. Use four 60 W (max.) E26 bulbs (not included).
